

## “Reserved Registration Period” for School Families Ends Tomorrow



Tomorrow, Friday, February 1, marks the end of the in-house registration period that is open to just Saint Andrew Catholic School families. The registration process

will be opened to all families who are members of Saint Andrew Catholic Church.

Because our class sizes are limited to 25 students per grade, the tiered registration system allows us to ensure that those already enrolled can reenroll without worry about being “bumped” by new incoming students.

On Saturday, February 2, our registration process is opened up to both current school families and new Church families. This becomes significant if there are only a few spots open in a grade level as is the case with our incoming Kindergarten and Grade 1 for 2019-2020.

Let’s say a grade level has a single spot left. If the Church family submits their registration prior to a school family, the Church family would be enrolled and the school family would be put on a waiting list. The tiered registration timeline is as follows:

January 18 thru February 1

February 2 thru February 15  
**Saint Andrew Catholic Church families**

February 16 thru February 22  
**Area Catholic Churches**

February 23  
**Open to the public**
