

This is an online service to help you deepen your Catholic faith anytime, anywhere using an internet connected computer, tablet or smart phone.


- Get Catholic movies, podcasts, Bible studies, ebooks and more for free on FORMED.

Getting Started

- Go to the web site: saint-andrew.formed.org
(Note this is a custom page easy registration page without the need for a special code as you will find on the commercial page of www.Formed.org)
- Click on the  button on the web page for easy registration



- Create and Account:
 - Enter your First and Last name
 - Enter an email address
*(Formed uses the email address as your username thus it **cannot** be used by more than one person. If you try this an error message will be displayed: Your email is already registered with formed.org)*
 - Enter your mailing address zip code
 - Enter a password using at least 8 characters, must have at least:
 - One number 0 – 9
 - One letter a – z (small or capital letters)
 - One special character such as: ? ! \$ #
 - Right click in the box I have to acknowledge:

- Then click the blue  button.





How do I log into the service?

1. Using an **internet connected** computer or tablet with **web browser application** like Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, Firefox etc. enter Saint Andrew's custom web page address:
saint-andrew.formed.org
2. The following web page will be displayed. Click the **LOGIN** button in the upper right.



3. A drop down dialog box will be displayed.
4. Enter the email address used to create your account.
5. Enter the password used to create your Formed account.
6. Click the **SUBMIT** button.

The main page of resources should then be displayed.



The Best Free Email Accounts

Free email accounts may seem like a dime a dozen, but there are some free services that stand way above the rest. This article will help guide you through the best free email accounts and which features make them the best.


When choosing a free email account, you'll want to look for a few characteristics to help you determine which one is best for you. The free email accounts will differ in how much email storage you get, what the interface looks like and how it can be customized, and what types of advanced features are included, like messaging, filters and the ability to import.

It also is probably important to you what your actual email address is. If you can't find one that you like at your first pick for a free email account, I recommend moving onto another one to see if it's available there. Remember to try different combinations and variations to get an address that's not taken.

Note: It's important to never reveal personal information in your email address, like your home address or phone number. It's common for email addresses to be a name with a couple numbers, or a word or phrase that means something.

Gmail

It's probably not a surprise that Gmail makes the top of my list for one of the best free email accounts. Gmail is Google's free email service that has a really nice and modern feel to it, and there are numerous shortcuts you can use to make it even easier to work with.



There are different themes you can apply to Gmail's interface to customize how it appears, tons of advanced settings, and the ability to create labels and filters, import email in from other email accounts, use a chat client, and, among other features, install gadgets (add-ons) to extend Gmail's functionality.

You can even view your Gmail messages without an internet connection if you install *Gmail Offline*.

Gmail shares a massive 15 GB of email storage with other Google services, which makes it super easy to share files with email recipients straight from your [Google Drive](#) account without having to leave Gmail, even files as large as 10 GB!

Since [Google Calendar](#) is another part of Google's list of services, it's equally as easy to integrate it with your emails, like to instantly add events taken from messages.


An email address at Gmail is set up in the format *example@gmail.com*. However, messages can be sent to *example@googlemail.com* as well, or even *example+(anything can be written in here)@gmail.com*, and they will still arrive in your regular Gmail inbox.

Tip: If you have a [YouTube](#) account, you can login to Gmail with the same information since YouTube is another Google service that's accessed through a Google account.

Outlook Mail

Outlook.com (Outlook Mail) is Microsoft's free email service that, like Gmail, has a solid interface that's easy to work with.

Free email accounts created with Outlook.com are configured as *example@outlook.com*.



Changing how you work with Outlook Mail couldn't be easier. You can very quickly change the color scheme of the page and choose where the reading pane should display.

I like how intuitive Outlook.com is - it's as easy as right-clicking an email to find further options like moving/deleting messages and searching for every email from that one sender, for example.

Email rules are supported with Outlook.com, which means you can set new messages to automatically move to a specified folder, be categorized, flagged or even forwarded if certain conditions are met.

In addition to regular mail features, you can also connect to Skype, Facebook and a couple other messaging services so you can stay connected without having to leave Outlook.com.

Like Gmail, Outlook Mail is closely related to Outlook Calendar so that events can be shared between the two. Also, add-ins are supported in the email service, too, ones like PayPal, DocuSign, Trello, Boomerang, GIPHY and many others.

Users can enjoy easy access to other free Microsoft services through Outlook Mail because it's part of [Microsoft Office Online](#).

Note: Microsoft's email addresses used to be setup as *@hotmail.com* and *@live.com*. If you have one of those addresses you can still login to Outlook.com, but any *new* accounts set up will include the newer *@outlook.com*.
