BURIAL OPTIONS

1. In-ground full body burial

We offer several options for in-ground burial throughout the cemetery.

2. In-ground crematin burial

We have a section dedicated to in-ground cremation burials for an individual interment.

3. Columbarium (see image below)

Offers you the option of choosing a niche as an above ground burial choice for cremation.

4. Fetal Remains, Infant and Child

The Cemetery Committee has designed a section marker and garden area placed within Section Four to mark a special burial place for your fetal remains, infant or child.

5. Natural (Future)

Currently a natural wildflower area being developed.
