

A SPECIAL PLACE TO REMEMBER OUR CHILDREN

The St. Henry Cemetery Committee has designated a special place in the parish cemetery for the burials of fetal remains, infants, and small children.

The Cemetery Committee has commissioned the design of a section marker and garden area to be placed within Section Four to mark this special burial place.

Burial sites range in size from four feet by five feet that will accommodate a small infant or fetal remains to sites measuring four feet by ten feet for burial of children up to six years of age (84 months).

In the stillness of the cemetery, we hear that great prayer of the early Christians,

“Maranatha!” “Lord Jesus, come!”



St. Henry Parish will provide these burial places at no charge to the family along with no burial or perpetual care fees. The family may wish to place a small personalized flush mount marker on the grave of their child. Information about markers, including dimensions and the process for obtaining stone markers, is available in the Parish Office.

At the Parish Cemetery

Following the celebration of the Funeral liturgy, it is proper that the Committal Rite and Farewell take place in the cemetery. Here the body is laid to rest among those members of this believing community who preceded this individual into Eternal Life.

Here the faithful profess the same sure conviction that one day body will be reunited with soul, the whole person will rise again in glory to be with the Risen Lord and Kingdom of God will be fully realized.
