Welcome back to Christ the King PSR for another school year. We look forward to working with you to help you fulfill your responsibility to teach your children the Catholic faith.

Classes meet on Mondays from 4:30 to 5:30 p.m. For the first class, we ask that all students come to the cafeteria and meet their teacher. This year's calendar is on the last page of this brochure.

Eighth graders will receive the sacrament of Confirmation on Friday November, 13th during 5:30 p.m. Mass. They will have their required Day in the Spirit on Thursday, November 12, 8:30am-2:00pm. More information about Confirmation will be sent home in the near future. Moving Confirmation to the fall requires that we begin preparation while our students are in the seventh grade. The seventh graders will begin their Confirmation study in November.

First Reconciliation for 2nd graders will be during lent. More information will be sent home as the time gets closer.

First Communion and Confirmation for our 4th graders will be on Friday, October 30th.

First Communion and Confirmation for our 3rd graders will be in the spring. more information will be sent home as the date approaches.

### Attendance Policy

Regular attendance is necessary so that your child will receive the best Catholic formation that we can provide. Parents are asked to call the school office (546-2159) if their child will be absent. An absence will be considered "excused" if advance notice is given along with a valid reason (for example, illness, family emergency, or parental visitation arrangements.) It will be necessary to make up the lessons missed. Chronic absences will result in the student needing to repeat the current grade level before receiving future sacraments. Any student who is to receive a sacrament must have been enrolled in PSR the previous year. Parents of children preparing for sacraments will be required to attend preparatory meetings during the year. Parental support, involvement, example, and teaching is essential in helping your child have a fruitful reception of the sacraments and to have a faithful, long-term Christian commitment. Dates are indicated on the calendar.

### Homework

Homework may be assigned in any PSR class. Parents are asked to help and support their children by reviewing lessons, checking information brought home, and reminding them to take materials back to class each week. Again, parental involvement helps to reinforce the importance of learning about our faith and good Christian values.

### Discipline Policy

Our PSR teachers teach the basics of our Catholic faith. As our time with your children is limited, it is important that the time be solely devoted to teaching. The behavior of students attending PSR is expected to reflect Christian values. Each teacher will make classroom expectations and rules clear to the children, as well as the consequences for not following them. Any student who consistently chooses to disregard rules will be referred to the office and a meeting with parents and student will be arranged.

### Student Safety

The students will receive personal safety training appropriate to their grade level on September 21st. Parents must sign a consent form available online at [www.ctkparish.com](http://www.ctkparish.com) and return that signed form to the school office.

### Registration

The completed registration form also available online at [www.ctkparish.com](http://www.ctkparish.com) must be completed and returned to the school office. The yearly PSR fee of \$40.00 is payable at the time of registration. Checks should be made payable to Christ the King Parish. You can bring your completed registration form to the school office by September 3rd.
