This letter is to update you on the activity of the St. Vincent de Paul conference here at St. John the Evangelist, during the year ending September 30, 2021.

Thanks to your generosity, and the efforts of the 20 members who comprise our SVdP group, assistance of over \$19,000 was provided to individuals and families in need. Parishioner donations fund the charitable activities of the Society and are greatly appreciated!

As you may know, the SVdP conference at St. John Daylight responds to requests for urgent services from families and individuals living within the borders of our parish, in addition to some from other SVdP conferences. The Society aids clients by providing food, clothing, household items and monetary assistance for rent, utilities and other emergency services. In addition, within Evansville, the Society operates the SVdP Food Pantry(809 N. Lafayette Ave) as well as the SVdP Thrift Store (767 E. Walnut St).

Inspired by Matthew 25:40 "Whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me," conference members spent a combined 1260 hours and drove over 7600 miles in helping 504 people. In addition to home visits, these numbers reflect members hosting the Thrift Store truck here twice, making a meal each month for the Ozanam Family Shelter and volunteering at the SVdP Thrift store and Food Pantry.
