Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Recently I informed all of you that our beloved music director and liturgy coordinator, Bernadette Heitzman, was going to be retiring, and that we had offered the position to Mister Jason Allen. Jason actually began employment officially on Tuesday of this last week. I wanted to take the opportunity to give a little biographical information about the newest member of our parish team.

Jason is a native of Perrysville, a small town in Vermillion County, Indiana, about 40 minutes north of Terre Haute. He is 34 years old, and is the middle of three sons. Educationally Jason is well rounded, being erudite in many different disciplines. He attended Wabash College, where he earned his BA in biology with a minor in literary Spanish.

Although his college major is not in music, there can be no doubt that his passion resides there. Through his experience growing up playing the piano, his involvement in high school band and chorus, and his college extracurriculars in glee club, orchestra, jazz band, and wind ensemble, in addition to many elective classes in music theory and composition, he is well equipped for his role in teaching and leading music!

In addition to his love for music, he has also maintained a vital spiritual life and profound interest in theology. A naturally inquisitive soul, through much study and discernment, he found himself drawn from his Baptist roots into Catholicism. He was admitted into full communion in the Catholic Church in 2016, and has voraciously absorbed much in the way of Catholic theology and the theology of Catholic liturgical music. I could learn a thing or two from him, truth be told!

While he was living in Terre Haute, he put his considerable musical gifts to work not by hoarding them, but by giving them away to others. He was part owner in an enterprise that taught music fundamentals and instruments to dozens of kids. I can tell that when he speaks of his students, he does so with a great deal of pride. In fact, this is yet another reason I feel that he was brought to us! It is my sincere hope that he can offer not only opportunities to teach adults and children choral singing for Mass, but make piano and musical lessons available to area kids as well. I feel that in a time when musical knowledge and proficiency is being dropped more and more from our educational systems and culture, the kind of resource that he would provide is invaluable.

In short, I am very excited that God paved the way for Mr. Allen to come to us here, and I look forward to what he can add to our Catholic life, Liturgy, and culture in the years to come!
