Seminarian of the Month

Send a note of encouragement to Aaron Herrenbruck at 500 Hill Drive, St. Meinrad, IN 47577. Aaron is in 1st Theology and his home Parish is St. Clement Parish in Boonville, Indiana. Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This week, especially due to the conflict that is ongoing in Ukraine, I wanted to do a bit of catechesis on the different persuasions of Christianity in that nation, and speak about some of the lesser known (to us in the West) portions of the Catholic Church, as well as the ancient churches that are not in union with us.

First of all, most people tend to draw no distinction between the terms "Catholic" and "Roman Catholic". These are not always synonymous. The term Catholic refers to all members of Christianity whose particular churches are united in communion with the Bishop of Rome and to the Universal Church. While "Roman" Catholics are the largest majority of Catholics, there are also those which are known as "Eastern" Catholics. These are comprised of 24 distinct cultural and geographic traditions that are not "Roman" or "Latin" rite Catholics (like us). These are in distinction from so-called "Orthodox" churches, which are not in union with Rome and are not "Catholic".

These divisions have occurred throughout the history of the Church, but most notably when the churches of the Greek or Eastern part of the old Roman Empire split off from communion with the Pope and the Catholic Church. This event is commonly known as the Great East-West Schism of 1054 AD. There were many reasons for this, from apparent differences in theology to the way the Liturgy (Mass) was conducted, to the way things were governed, to just plain political and cultural divergence.

Over the centuries, however, portions of those Orthodox churches made moves to reunite in communion with Rome, while still preserving their own unique expressions of liturgy and culture. They ultimately submit to the authority of the Supreme Pontiff, but are otherwise free to govern themselves as they best see fit, provided that they of course adhere to the Truths of the Faith.

Ukraine is of course a largely Christian nation, with about 71% of the nation identifying as some persuasion of Christian. About 10% are Ukrainian Byzantine Rite Catholics, about 1% are Latin Rite Catholics, and most of the rest are some division of Orthodox, either Ukrainian or Russian Orthodox.

Confused yet? Me too. To be perfectly honest, these divisions in the Church are among the most tragic things about our Catholic history. Two parts of the Christian world who have valid sacraments, theology, and beautiful liturgical and spiritual traditions stretching back to Christ and the Apostles, and yet division persists. The worst part of it all is that it (like the current military conflict) is mostly because of pride, ambition, and less than holy motivations. May we all one-day honor Christ's desire, "That they all be one."
