Seminarian Keith Hart,

There is an oft quoted saying about the Eucharist from Catholic novelist J.R.R. Tolkien, "I put before you the one great thing to love on earth: the Blessed Sacrament. There you will find romance, glory, honor, fidelity, and the true way of all your loves on earth." In Christ we find the fullness of fidelity, courage, and love that all the stories of adventure, heroism, and romance points towards. Christ died for us: *God* died for us, after taking on our human flesh in the Incarnation. Though we deserve punishment, He bore our punishment for us, taking from us the wages of sindeath- and giving us the hope of everlasting life. In the celebration of the Eucharist, especially on the solemn day of Corpus Christi, we are reminded of all that Christ has done for us, in case it has slipped our minds since the Easter we celebrated just a couple months ago.

There is a type of Japanese pottery called kintsugi where a shattered piece of pottery is fixed by gluing the broken pieces back together again with gold. What is broken becomes more beautiful than it was before. In the breaking of the Bread, the broken and crucified Body of Christ that is represented to God the Father and shown to us as bread, we find the glory of the Resurrection shining through the sufferings of Our Lord. Christ can take our sufferings and overcome them, turning mourning into joy and repeated sins into conquered victories. We find this victory in Christ, who turned a crown of thorns into a crown more glorious than any band of gold, nails into the richest of regalia, drops of blood more precious than rubies, and a cross of torture into a throne of salvation. In this season of Ordinary Time, lets commit ourselves more firmly in love and devotion to the Eucharist so that Christ may conqueror our sins and that we may share in His triumphant victory. Let us all be transformed in Christ.
