

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

For more than six years now we have celebrated our Wednesday Mass at 6 pm to facilitate working parishioners' ability to come to make an extra Mass each week. This has worked quite well, especially in terms of being able to offer the Sacraments of Penance as well as the Eucharist in conjunction with opportunities for catechesis. This has also afforded our high school youth group the opportunity to combine their activities with the sacramental life.

In order to make a greater allowance for after-Mass catechetical programs as well as to make it easier to come straight from the workplace, I have decided to change this Mass time to 5:30 pm. It is my hope that this will make it easier for folks to come from work, attend Mass, and still adequately be able to observe the pre-communion 1-hour fast. This will also make it possible for our youth group kids to attend Mass more consistently and still be able to have time to do their recreation/bonding activities, have instruction and discussion, and still be able to get home in a more reasonable time to complete homework and other tasks. Please note that these changes will take place beginning August 17th.

I am sure folks are also still wondering what the long-term plan is for the weekend Mass times. This has still not yet been determined, but I hope it soon will be. I fully realize that changing the schedule on anything, especially things as important as the Holy Mass; can be a challenge for some. It is my hope that this (as well as any forthcoming) changes will not only be acceptable to people, but actually fruitful to their spiritual life and make the Sacraments even more accessible.

Please pray for me as I continue to pray for you. As we priests come to wear more and more hats throughout our diocese, we are in greater and greater need for the divine assistance you call down for us!

Finally, and most especially, pray for the young men preparing to step into the priestly ministry, most notably our seminarian Keith Hart! Next weekend will be his last time with us before he resumes theological studies at St. Meinrad. Please make a point to wish him well and lift him up before the Father's throne! I truly appreciate his being here with us and his willingness to dispose himself to the service of God and his people! Thank you, Keith!!!


