Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I cannot believe how quickly this summer has flown by. It seems like just last week, we were celebrating our graduating seniors, and now they are all heading off to college or careers for the first time and moving towards adulthood. I want to ensure all our students and families know of my prayers for them as they all get back into the swing of a new school year. I hope it is filled with many blessings and lots of growth in your faith life this year and that our Heavenly Father will draw you even closer to him! With the start of school also comes the start of several of our kick-offs for faith formation this year.

The first I would like to talk about is our Youth Group here at St. John. This might be a biased opinion, but I can wholeheartedly say that we have the most wonderful group of youth that come here faithfully every Wednesday night to grow in their faith together through discussion, fellowship, and learning to deepen their prayer life through practice and support from their peers. This group of teens is a wonderful part of our parish family, bringing so much life and vibrancy to our parish. It is a joy to be with these teens, watching them grow and thrive in their faith life, and learning the true meaning of strong and virtuous friendships. These relationships will accompany them and support them far beyond the walls of our parish. If your teen has not plugged into our youth group yet, I strongly recommend that they do. This is a wonderful opportunity for our kids to grow in faith together, and I can promise they will not regret getting involved with this wonderful and faithful youth group. Meetings will start this Wednesday, August 17, with 5:30 Mass. The Teens will then play games, have formation time, and share a meal before they are ready for pick up at 8:00 pm.

Secondly, I would like to invite all men to the Men's Faith Formation. Last year about 40 men from our parish and other parishes in the diocese gathered to learn more about what it means to be a strong Catholic Man in your homes, your places of work, and your relationships. This time together was fruitful indeed, and it allowed us to grow together and support each other in the roles to which God has called us. This year starting after the 5:30 pm Mass on Wednesday, August 17th, we will be sharing a meal provided by the Men in the Knights of Columbus group along with some adult beverages and then starting faith formation following the meal and fellowship time. I would love for any adult men (must be at least 18 and out of high school) to join us for this year's men's faith formation featuring the virtue series Fr. Kapaun's Men. Servant of God Father Emil Kapaun was a heroic Catholic priest and Army chaplain who spent his life serving his fellow men on the battlefields and in Korea's prison camps. He inspired men to band together and keep fighting, and his story has been inspiring men ever since. I am excited to see you there!

We have so many good things starting and many others to come. We will be starting religious education on September 11th. We will also be hosting the nationally and internationally known Catholic Speaker Jason Evert for a double feature talk on September 15th! I hope and pray all of you will truly consider taking advantage of these many opportunities to grow deeper in your faith life and to grow in your desire to spend time with our Heavenly Father. He is waiting in hopeful anticipation for you to spend time with Him and get to know Him in a more personal and more profound way. Let the race begin!
