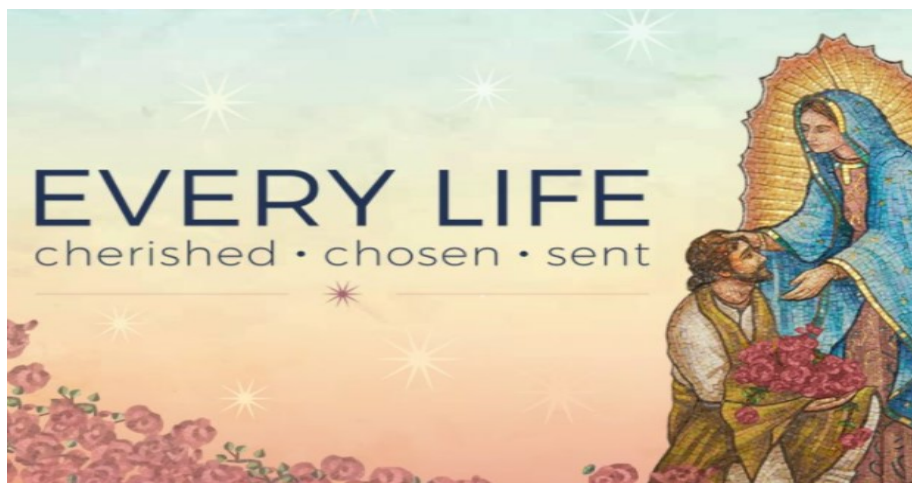

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This coming week I have the privilege of accompanying several youths from our parish on the annual March for Life trip. This trip is a way we can peacefully march and stand up for those who don't have a voice. We are able to proclaim the good news that all life from conception to natural death has equal dignity, value, and worth. The pro-life movement has always been strong in this parish, having many members on the local board for Southwest Indiana Right to Life, having others in our parish being heavily involved with Peer's Project, 40 Days for Life, the Gabriel Project, Project Rachel and many more organizations that all go back to respecting life, defending it and fighting for it. Of this, I could not be more proud!

The March for Life is just one of many ways we can help to overturn Roe v. Wade. Knowing that it is not possible for all to make the trip I wanted to talk about some ways that you can help defend life here locally. One way is to take a step back and look at your family. Abortion has destroyed many families and this has always been the intent of the evil one... as Saint John Paul II said "As the family goes, so goes the nation and so goes the whole world in which we live." So, this week I ask that you take time with your family to sit down and pray a rosary for the end to abortion, or attend an extra Mass together, or a holy hour, whatever you can do, try and do it as a family. When families pray together it is a powerful thing to behold, and it is even more powerful to see how God puts these prayers into action. Strong and reverent families are God's answer to Satan's plan to destroy families.

Another opportunity to help pray for the end of abortion is the Mass and holy hour for Life. Bishop Siegel will celebrate a diocesan Mass for Life at St. Benedict Cathedral on Friday, January 21, 2022 at 5:30pm. The Mass will be followed by a Holy Hour. I encourage all that are able to attend to do so.

Lastly, I would like you all to pray for all those that will be attending the March and for their safety as they head to Washington D.C. This has not been a smooth or easy road for this trip to happen... as I like to say, that's when you know the fruit it will bear will be good. These young people are full of passion and zeal for life and I ask that almighty God increase that passion in them and that maybe this trip, this march, and all of these prayers might be the final push to overturn Roe vs Wade. Through the intercession of our Lady of Guadalupe, the one that crushed the serpent's head, and the Holy Family, we ask for your mercy your guidance and your protection. If you could all join in praying the following prayer from our Bishop...

YOUNG PERSON'S PRAYER FOR LIFE

Father in heaven, source of all life, we give you thanks for having created us in your own image and likeness.

It is you who bestow dignity and worth on every human life, from conception to natural death.

Grant us the grace to always value this precious gift in ourselves and others.

May we have the wisdom to recognize the face of your Son in all those in need, especially those who are the weakest and most vulnerable.

Through the guidance of the Holy Spirit, enable us to build and defend a Culture of Life in our families, schools and communities, through the testimony of our words and example.

Let us never become discouraged in our efforts, but may we always place our hope in You.

We pray through the intercession of Mary, the Mother of Your Son, Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you forever and ever.
