

For this article, I want to talk about some of the important things about the month we just entered, October. This month might be the most popular month of the year partially because October means fall, and fall means beautiful weather and changing leaves. Many outdoor activities to enjoy with others like hiking and bonfires. There is a crispness to the air, allowing us to enjoy the beauty of God's creation surrounding us. As Catholics, October is a big month for us, too, not just because it allows us to bask in the splendor and awe of God's creation but also for the fact that this month is dedicated to the most Holy Rosary, one of the most powerful weapons we have given to us from our Blessed Mother.

Many great Saints had a strong devotion to the Rosary. One of them was St. Dominic, who was given the Rosary in its form that we know and still recite today. St. Dominic received the Rosary during a time of prayer in 1208 when he saw an apparition of our Blessed Mother. Another great Saint that had a devotion to the most Holy Rosary was Pope Saint John Paul II. The Rosary was his favorite prayer and he would pray all 15 decades every day and was the one responsible for adding the Luminous Mysteries making his daily devotion 20 decades a day. JPII also said that when he prays the Rosary, he is "Contemplating the face of Jesus through the eyes of Mary." St. Therese describes the Rosary as a long chain that links heaven and earth and that when we pray to one end, Mary is holding the other end. St. Padre Pio described the Rosary as our greatest weapon.

It is a powerful weapon indeed. It has been the key weapon to winning battles like the battle of Lepanto. In the 16th Century, the Ottoman Empire attacked Venice at the Battle of Lepanto. The Ottoman Empire was intent on destroying Christianity forever. Hopelessly outnumbered, the Pope begged everyone to pray the Rosary, and they did. Miraculously they defeated the Ottoman Empire, and Mary was given the title Our Lady of Victory. Another great example of the power of the Rosary was when Mary appeared in Fatima. She spoke of only two things that could bring an end to the Great War (WWI): saying the Rosary and offering up suffering. Religious orders wear long rosaries hanging down their side from their belts. Why? Because it is a weapon! This is the way that knights once carried their swords. And it is so much more powerful than a sword.

I could go on and on about what a powerful prayer this is, but I encourage you to check it out for yourself. I am calling on the parents to try this month to lead your family in praying the Rosary. Bring your intentions to our Heavenly Mother so she can, like a good Mother, advocate for her children and show us the power of God's love for all of us. If you want something to help strengthen your family or a way to pray for your children or grandchildren, or any loved ones in your life, the Rosary is the most powerful way to start. So, I strongly encourage you to take up this heavenly weapon and pray for and with your families so that they may be strong and always stay close to God. As Pope Saint John Paul II said, "How beautiful is the family that recites the Rosary every evening." Know of my prayers for you, and please keep praying for me.


