

Lent is a season of the elementals. We simplify our lives. We simplify our liturgies. It is all a move to 'get back to the basics', so to speak. This is a normal process of human life, and one that I think everyone understands on one level or another. Spring cleaning and having a garage sale is a common thing that we do when we simply have too much clutter in our lives. It is healthy, it is cleansing, and it helps us to determine what is most important and necessary in our lives.

Lent is also, as I have said before, not only a time to subtract things such as sin and distraction, but also a time to enrich and add. This is especially true in matters of faith and devotion. Many people place a renewed emphasis on the Rosary. We may pick the devotion of the Stations of the Cross back up, especially in this season. However, one gift that we here at St. John's have that many parishes do not is the opportunity to come to an adoration chapel and 'get to know the Boss' a little bit better by spending time with Him.

It is impossible to overstate the importance of the Eucharist in our lives as Catholics. Without the Eucharist, we would lose the special sacramental Presence of Christ in the world today. We would miss the greatest source of grace available to us to live lives of holiness and virtue. Mass is the way most Catholics have of encountering this sacramental presence of Jesus. However, the Church has recognized for hundreds of years that simply spending time with the Lord in adoration is immensely beneficial as well. It is a way of extending the experience and contact with Jesus beyond the encounter we have on Sunday. Moreover, we can come and pour ourselves out to Him here at the St. Claire Chapel anytime we are joyful, sorrowful, weak, or discouraged. It is a great gift.

If you already have a regular hour in the chapel, I probably don't have to tell you much about the peace that it can bring to you and the other relationships in your life, and I thank you for making that commitment of your time. I want to extend special thanks for those who have newly signed up for an hour with Jesus during our soon to be extended weekday hours. If you have not yet signed up for a regular hour, I encourage you to think honestly about making the time for it. Yes, it is a sacrifice of your time. Yes, at first you may wonder 'what to do' with that hour. Just 'waste time with Jesus'! I think after a while, when you notice the change in your spirit, you will find that it is not a waste of time at all. In fact, you may find that it is one of the most important appointments on your calendar.
