

This next weekend, our parish celebrates the Confirmation of fourteen of our teenagers. This is a wonderful and Holy Spirit-filled event that we get the honor of witnessing and interceding for our Confirmation candidates. The sacrament of Confirmation is commonly mistaken for a final step into Catholic adulthood. This is not the case, and it is, however, the final sacrament of Christian initiation to Confirm upon the candidate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. This brings our Baptism, our First Holy Communion, and then Confirmation into the fullness and deep and more perfect unity with God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

Many people wonder why there is so much preparation for Confirmation and the sacraments in general. If we truly understood the magnitude of the graces that are being bestowed upon us in these sacraments, this would surely not be the question we would ask. The real question would and should be, why is there not more? When the apostles received the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, they were sent out to proclaim the Gospel and spread God's word. They were given the grace to fight for and defend and proclaim their faith at all costs. All except for one went as far as to be martyred for their faith. We, as Catholics, are called to no lesser standards than they were. God has created each and everyone one of us to help complete and fulfill his mission here on earth, which is to get as many souls to his loving and merciful embrace as possible.

These teens have been preparing for many years now and during this final week of preparation, I ask you take this time to intercede for them through prayer, and what better way to do that than the prayers that were given to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska by Jesus. St. Faustina was a young, uneducated nun in a convent of the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Poland during the 1930s. She came from a poor family that struggled during the years of World War I. St. Faustina was given many messages from our Lord Jesus and they all centered around our need to trust in Jesus, to ask for mercy on all of us and on the whole world. So as this weekend is Divine Mercy Sunday, I ask you to remember our Confirmation kids in your prayers and ask for them to always trust in God and his everlasting Mercy for us always and forever.

As you pray for others during this don't forget to ask for God's mercy on yourself. We will have a couple of opportunities for praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet on Sunday. The first opportunity will be at 8:00 am this Sunday between our 6:45 am and 9:30 am Masses. We will also say the Chaplet after the 9:30 Mass. I will be helping hear confessions at St. John Newburgh for a group Divine Mercy service. This will start at 2:00 pm in the church with one hour of confessions which as Catholics is one of the best ways to receive and ask for God's mercy, and end with a blessing of the Divine Mercy image at 3 PM, followed by singing the Divine Mercy Chaplet. All are welcome and encouraged to attend. "O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!"
