Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

St. John's building project is well underway, no doubt you have realized over these last several months! We are projected to complete construction either in August or in September of this year. This will no doubt be a great boon for our parish and the number of activities and programs we will be able to accommodate now and in the future. Glory be to God!

I wanted to take a moment to explain some of the budget changes and financial burdens that will be upcoming for this fiscal year that we have just begun. The last year's budget called for a weekly collection income of \$13,060/week. We have been exceedingly successful at meeting and slightly exceeding this figure as well as keeping our expenses down. However, some changes are now necessary because of the expansion of the facility. This new budget accounts for increased utility base costs, as well as additional utility consumption due to the simple increase in floor space and increased maintenance and custodial costs for the same reasons. We along with the finance council have worked hard to trim expenses to allow for these changes and keep the needed collection to a minimum. I am happy to announce that our weekly needed collection for maintaining operations will be \$13,485/week, a very modest increase of \$425/week.

However, I simply want to inform you all that there is an additional expense that will begin upon the completion of the building. The loan we needed to take out with the diocese in order to complete the project will begin being paid, and this will result in a significant increase in actual weekly spending. The amount and terms of the loan will demand an additional \$2600/week over and above the base weekly collection. Our plan is to use some of our remaining funds in savings to help to offset a portion of that weekly burden, but not nearly all. The term for the loan is 7 years.

I wanted to extend a very heartfelt thank-you to all who have pledged and funded our capital campaign thus far. None of this would have been possible without you! I also would like to make the appeal to those who have perhaps not yet contributed to prayerfully consider doing so. I of course greatly appreciate the consistent generosity of folks here at St. John's. You all know how much I love talking about money (that is a joke), but because of that generosity, I very seldom have to! I simply wanted to give everyone a heads-up and let you all know where we stand financially, especially those who watch the numbers each week. Let us forge onward in faith!

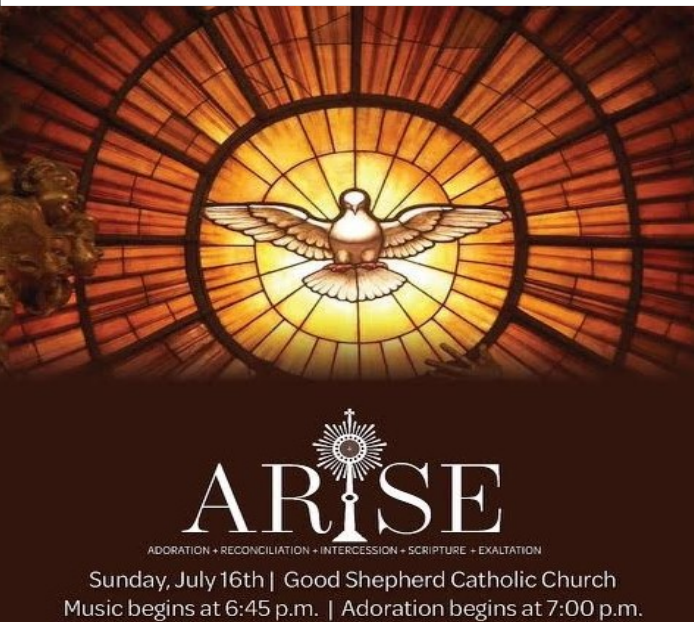
