



Dear Brother and Sisters in Christ,

As we prepare during this advent for the Christmas season, I must of course note that this Sunday is Gaudete Sunday. Gaudete means, "rejoice" in Latin, and I must say I have much to rejoice in here at St. John's in all the good that is done for others and how the Joy of the Lord is spread so beautifully.

Last week I went Christmas Caroling with our youth group on St. Nick's Day as one of their service projects. They made forty Christmas stockings with different items that helped better teach the corporal and spiritual works of mercy (those are of course to feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, ransom the captive, bury the dead, shelter the stranger, comfort the sick, and clothe the naked; the spiritual works are to admonish the sinner, instruct the ignorant, counsel the doubtful, comfort the sorrowful, bear wrongs patiently, forgive all injuries, and pray for the living and the dead). We decided to deliver the stockings and sing some carols while we did it and the joy that we felt and in those we visited was tangible! We began the evening at one of the local nursing homes. When we got there, we were a bit worried, because it was like a ghost town. We had trouble finding staff and found few residents out socializing. A very kind nurse came to help us and encouraged us to feel free to start walking through the halls and singing. Soon over 30 kids and several adult volunteers were streaming through the halls! We were concerned that we would be startling folks, but as we finished songs, we could hear little claps and shouts from the different rooms ringing out with either a "Merry Christmas" or a "Thank you and that was beautiful." The place started to come alive as more residents came to their doors, and staff started to emerge to see what all the commotion was about. We had people following us through the halls and singing along.

The true Christmas spirit started to grow and fill people with joy, not just the residents, but the staff and us as well. It was the type of joy that only comes from the Lord. We then went to several other homes, sang, and delivered stockings. We so desperately wanted to do more and see more folks, but time prevented us from visiting more than a handful. However, it was clear that even this small act of kindness of just singing a Christmas song brought so much hope and love into everyone's hearts. The sheer gratitude that was given was humbling. Our youth group teens were fantastic, as were their parents in donating money and items to make this possible. It was a great reminder that the true meaning of Christmas is to give and sacrifice for others; it is to go out of one's way to make the extra visit or make the extra treat.

In addition, our Little Flower Group made treats for a low-income nursing home where most who live there receive nothing. Our Gabriel project flooded the commons with a mountain of gifts for those who are less fortunate. Our Knights of Columbus did a Thanksgiving food drive, and our Altar Society took up donations for the Ozanam Shelter and Borrowed Hearts. All of these helped meet a corporal or spiritual work of mercy in some way, and this is indeed how to spread the genuine and authentic Joy of the Lord.

I am so proud to be pastor of such a radiant and generous parish. Let us all give thanks to God and rejoice in Him as we give ourselves as gifts to others!
