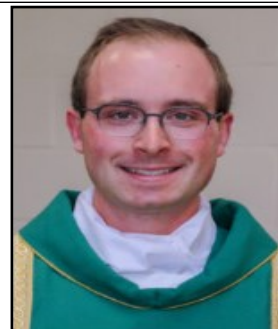
I implore everyone in both parishes to please offer up prayers for these young men and women to be open to those gifts, so that God may transform them and the face of the earth!
