Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As I indicated in my homilies, though the world is in most places paused and paralyzed, the Mysteries of our salvation in Christ continued to be celebrated. The blessing and lighting of the new Easter candle and the light being restored to the church after the Resurrection of Jesus continued as it has for nearly the last two thousand years. Though the work of Jesus might be obscured by circumstance and adversity, it cannot be stopped. This should give us all hope, no matter where we may find ourselves.

I saw families who likely spent a good part of their morning getting little ones ready in their Easter best to come to their church for such a short visit and a blessing, each in their turn. To see families show concretely their love for Jesus, their parish, and yes even their priest was very moving. I will not forget it!

As we also celebrate this weekend Divine Mercy Sunday, let us continue to bask in the hope that we place in God's infinite Mercy shown us in Jesus. He opened his side to let us have access to the saving fountains of baptism and the Eucharist. Let us continue, on this day especially, to call out to God and invoke His Mercy upon ourselves and all the world, most especially those who are yet far off from Him.
