Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I am tempted to let my heart be heavy. I won't deny it. I see so much division, fear, and discord in our nation and our world. The division that we see even to the point of aggression in many of our cities over the death of George Floyd. The fear of the threat of a virus that we still don't fully understand. Even the recent Supreme Court decision that leaves our churches, schools and other institutions seemingly open to attack from anyone who disagrees with our beliefs concerning human sexuality and God's authority over it. It saddens me greatly.

Fortunately, that division and fear are not so prevalent nor deep in our parish, though to say it is absent would be untruthful as well. On a smaller but not insignificant level, we have divisions even here and throughout our diocese concerning how reopening Masses has been executed, for instance. There are folks who desire that any risk to health be eliminated at any cost. On the other side there are those who do not wish to voluntarily modify their behaviors from the norm for fear of being manipulated by authority. And of course, there is the ever-present division between those who accept and cling to the perennial teachings of the Church and Her Magisterium, and those who reject it on one or several points.

Friday's Solemnity of the Sacred Heart reminds us that the only solution to the growing cold of our love for one another and for God is the grace of Jesus' intense and infinite love for the world and for each of us. He burns with love for us. He bleeds in agony for our sins and forgetfulness of Him. He showed the world through His messages to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, which assure us that He is not a vengeful but a loving God, and He desires that we allow ourselves to be formed ever more in His image. Through His willingness to suffer and die for us he wants us to abandon our own fear of earthly death and suffering and place our confidence in his promise of everlasting life. He wants that we trust His divine teachings and laws and morality and submit ourselves to them. He wants us to be gentle with those who do not yet see the healing and enlivening power of those teachings. He wants our hearts not to burn with hatred for one another but to burn with the fire of love and concern for those other than ourselves.

It may sound trite, but Jesus is truly the cure to all the diseases that afflict us.

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, Have Mercy on us.


