Dreams

Dreams have interested me since I was little. I can still recall a few of them from over 20 years ago. I became more curious about dreams as I grew older, and when it came time to choose a thesis topic in architecture school, I figured it was a good time to explore my dreams a little deeper. What causes them? How does the mind create them? My curiosity only grew as I studied more and more. In seminary, we also had to write a thesis, so, naturally, I chose to write on dreams. What I found was that the mind's creation of a dream could be compared rather closely with how we understand God's Creation and involvement in the world.

Long story short, a dream is a communication of the unconscious self to the conscious self, and since the unconscious isn't capable of speaking to you directly, the language it uses to speak is made from your real-life experiences and feelings. For example, a classmate told me about his recurring dream where he was on a ship with his ex-wife. This man used to be in the Navy in real life, and when he was onboard the ship, he felt trapped because he couldn't get off. You may see where this is going. He dreamt that he was with his ex-wife because he felt trapped in their relationship together. The entire scene of the ship was a stand-in for the feelings he had towards her. Whatever is remembered first and most vividly upon waking is typically what the unconscious is bringing to the attention of consciousness. Even smaller objects in dreams can be packed densely with meaning.

So how does this relate to God's involvement in His Creation? Just as the unconscious remains invisible to consciousness, so too does God remain invisible to the physical world. In order to communicate Himself to us, there must be some kind of manifestation (invisible to visible) of Himself in the world that we can take in through our senses. All of creation does this for us. The study of phenomenology, of which Pope JPII was an advocate, dives deep into the concept of experiencing all of physical reality.

How do we know that God exists? One of the best ways (the best way, really) to know for certain is that He sent His son, Jesus, as the manifestation of Himself. Everything that the Son stands for mirrors what the Father is. Jesus never claimed to be God the Father, but always referred to himself as the One sent by the Father. "Have I been with you all this time, Philip, and you still do not know me? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father?'" (JN 14:9).

Just as a dream gives us an insight into our deepest thoughts and desires leading to a greater self-knowledge, so too does Christ give us an insight into Who the Father is, and therefore, who we are as sons and daughters created in His image and likeness.
