Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I hope that your summer is one of relative leisure and blessing and restfulness. For me, it is definitely going too fast though!

As many of you well know, last weekend we were able to install the new rail in the sanctuary prior to Clint Johnson's leaving the parish in preparation to go to Rome. As I said at the Masses, he was instrumental in the design and construction of the rail. I have to say it turned out even better than I expected. He managed to give us something that pulls off the difficult balance of harmonizing with the more contemporary furnishings of the current church while also being consonant with the old elements in the church. These of course came from the previous parish church in Warrick county. Clint spent many hours in the woodshop both with me and on his own. Please remember him fondly in your prayers as he begins his theological studies at the Angelicum in Rome!

I also wanted to recognize some other individuals that helped to make all of this possible. First of all, I'd like to recognize Ed May of Ed's Woodcraft in Haubstadt. Ed is a parishioner at Sts. Peter and Paul there. I have known Ed for years and he has graciously allowed me access to his shop for many personal projects over the years. This would not have been possible without him generously allowing me to tie up his shop for weeks with this very large project. If you need any kind of full-custom cabinetry from a good man of proven craftsmanship (and great faith), Ed is a great man to contact.

Many thanks to Fehrenbacher Cabinets for supplying the oak stripping used to create the laminated curved rails and most of the raw materials.

The arches on the rail were CNC machined by Brandon Dilger on his self-built routing table. This saved enormous amounts of time on the bandsaw cutting out 40 arches freehand with questionable consistency. Brandon also helped with the installation last Saturday.

Andy Preske, member of Holy Redeemer parish (and Knights of Columbus council) sprayed the shellac finish on all oak portions. Andy is a wizard with any kind of fabrication work. The guy is a genius who can literally do anything. Andy specializes in copper and other fine metal work and roofing, and owns and operates The Copper Shop, also in Haubstadt.

Finally, thanks so much to Jerry and Karen Miller. Jerry spent more after-hours time in the shop with us than I can count, and his own eye for craftsmanship and his resourcefulness helped us pull this off far more quickly, smoothly, and professionally, and Karen hand-painted the gold highlights on the rail. Thank you so much to all and to each! May God be praised!

Parish Secretary

Non-Exempt (Hourly); Full-Time Position. Salary commensurate with experience. Reports to the Parish Pastor. The Administrative Secretary is the first person with whom people come in contact when they arrive. The Administrative Secretary must have excellent interpersonal, writing and verbal communication skills. The person who fills this position must be a self-starter who can work with minimal supervision and be able to handle many tasks in a dynamic environment.
