Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As promised in my homily last Sunday, we have included the response letter from Archbishop Cordileone from San Francisco to the letter from a group of Catholic politicians in the US congress. I invite you to read his responses to the objections and positions of these politicians and share as necessary.

Many of the arguments floated by said politicians are commonly heard when it comes to questions of morality and public policy. The good archbishop answers their positions appropriately. There is so much that is said to confuse, oversimplify, or even overcomplicate certain moral principles. Chief of these is the attempt to assert that all moral issues are on the same level of gravity. This is simply not so. Material poverty is emphatically not on the same level as the deprivation of the right to life of the most innocent and defenseless. This is not a difficult concept, but unless we carefully weigh positions and arguments objectively and without personal biases, we can be easily taken in by a position that allows us to stay in our comfort zone.

Lamentably, we seem as a society to no longer be able to have a real conversation or a rational argument anymore. I personally made the decision some years ago to turn off the talking heads and news programs that had 'debate' because it simply ended up being a shouting match between two sides that had already made up their minds. I find this most concerning, and it is an obstacle that will be very hard to get past as a nation. The only solution is to really seek the truth. We must do so in a humble but confident way. Humble in the sense that we know that we are not the source of truth. Confident in that Jesus is.

Those who define their beliefs and their worldview by a simple political party or agenda to the exclusion of the demands of Jesus Christ may find it to be more comfortable or familiar in the short term. However, that will save no one, and certainly will not bring us as individuals or as a society any closer to true happiness or to the living God.




### Catholic Center and Sarto Retreat House Part-time After-Hours Employee Position
