Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend's celebration of the Baptism of the Lord brings to a close the Christmas season. As we get ready to step back into Ordinary Time, we are once again meant to turn our attention to sanctifying the everyday world around us. The "ordinary" stuff of life can be made extraordinary in Christ.

One of those 'ordinary' things that God elevates to something extraordinary is the understanding and expression of married love and human sexuality. This is a subject and concept that is greatly distorted and corrupted in our world today. Instead of true love, the cheap facsimile of lust is foisted upon us by the culture. This is terrifyingly true especially when it comes to our children. The culture of lust and death presses in on them with peer pressure to act unchastely, to say nothing of the pornification they face if they access internet media. They can also be corrupted by institutional initiatives. Even in many public school districts throughout the country today, kids as young as kindergarten age are instructed in sexual activity of all stripes. This is criminal in God's eyes, but all too often even we faithful Catholics are undereducated concerning the truth and freedom of God's law of love, and don't know how to adequately guide our children in this most important aspect of human life.

To that end, we once again are partnering with Holy Redeemer parish to offer the LoveEd program for children in grades 4th-8th, as well as their parents. This awesome program helps to equip parents to speak to their own children in a modest, proper, comfortable yet intimate, and Godly way about the subject of human sexuality. I truly believe in the power and pertinence of this program and encourage parents to take advantage of this great resource.

Too often I believe parents are nervous about even broaching the subject of sex. This can lead to their not teaching their kids anything at all and letting the world teach them instead, or wondering how to teach and approach it properly themselves. It also provides the opportunity for parents and families to get to know each other and to network and support one another in other aspects of Catholic family life.

Diocesan Policy: Report and Inform

The Diocese of Evansville has in place a policy that requires that any allegation of child abuse must be reported to civil authorities. If an allegation involves the sexual abuse of a minor by diocesan personnel, the Victim Assistance Coordinator must also be informed. Sexual misconduct violates human dignity and the mission of the church. The spiritual well-being of all victims, their families, and others in the community is of particular concern to the church.

Report child abuse

Every allegation of child abuse must be reported to Child Protection Services, an agency of Indiana state government. CPS Toll-free: 800-800-5556. Local law enforcement: 9-1-1.

Report and inform

In the event of an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor (a person under 18) by diocesan personnel, report the allegation to authorities, and inform the Victim Assistance Coordinator for the diocese: Toll-free: 866-200-3004, Local: 812-490-9565.
