Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As of the writing (and reading) of this article (the 47th anniversary of Roe vs. Wade), hundreds of thousands of folks from all states and walks of life will have been involved in the March for Life. Hundreds of people from the tri-state will have participated as well. Both the Diocese of Evansville and the Southwest Indiana Right to Life have for years organized groups for this pilgrimage of Faith.

By your reading, these people will probably be on their way back from the trip, including many of our youth group kids and many other parishioners. Having been on the pilgrimage many times in college, seminary, and priesthood, I can attest to the inspiration of being involved in such a monumental movement. Very often the march itself from the Washington monument to the Supreme Court Building itself involves fully half a million people. Truly amazing.

Last year there was a rare focus on the march because of erroneous reporting that a Covington Catholic High School student was harassing a Native American protestor. This not only was proven false, but news outlets that the student's family are suing have since begun to pay settlements out of court for defamation. Besides this kerfuffle, one will almost never see any mention of it on the part of national news outlets. Huge groups of people peacefully marching on the supreme court in defense of life is not exactly the narrative they want people to hear (for whatever reason). But the narrative is this: ever since the first March for Life back in 1974, the numbers of participants have grown drastically. The first had approximately 20,000 people. Estimated numbers in recent years exceed 600,000.

The fact of the matter is that fewer and fewer people, especially the young, are in support of the practice of abortion, pundits notwithstanding. Couple this with recent developments surrounding the Supreme Court in the last two years, and it is now clearly conceivable that we could see an end to legalized abortion in the near future!

I am also inspired by the great organization, passion, and persistence/perseverance of the people involved in standing up for the right to life. Most movements will build and then fade to oblivion within the span of 47 years. I firmly believe that the fact that this one is stronger than ever is a sign that it is of God.

Please continue to pray for and support this movement. It's not just for babies. It's for moms. It's for dads. It's for all those who are faceless, nameless, and forgotten. It's for our nation. Without the deeper awareness of God and every human being's inherent dignity, our nation is doomed to be a short-lived morass of anything-goes chaos. God wants so very much more for us than that.

House of Discernment Winter Update

The spring semester is underway for college students across our diocese. Likewise, the formation and discernment for the 3 residents at the Father Deydier House of Discernment has begun. Craig Wilmes, Holy Redeemer, Michael Mosbey, Good Shepherd, and Chase Riecker, St. Isidore are each moving forward in their prayer and decision-making as they seek to hear and follow the voice of Jesus Christ in their lives.

On Dec. 22, about 20 young men gathered at the House for "Man Christmas". Dinner and games preceded a white-elephant style gift-exchange of protein bars, razors, tools and other things guys enjoy. The evening concluded with prayer in the House Chapel. Over Christmas break, many of the seminarians of the Diocese of Evansville stayed at the House to pray, study and to be together.

The monthly "Savio Night" gathering of faith formation for teenage guys has grown so large that the group has now been split into two. 6th & 7th grade boys kept the title "Savio" & gather at the House before prayer & faith formation at Sacred Heart Church, & the older group, now called "Giorgio" after Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, joins for the overlapping prayer and faith formation time. Then, the older group gathers at the House as the younger group departs. 88 young men from 18 parishes have attended this school year.

Monday Night "Holy Hour & Mass for Vocations" continues to grow. A Christmas gathering co-sponsored by Annunciation's "Made for More" young adult ministry brought more than 300 men, women & children to pray in the presence of the Lord on Dec. 30.

Diocesan Policy: Report and Inform

The Diocese of Evansville has in place a policy that requires that any allegation of child abuse must be reported to civil authorities. If an allegation involves the sexual abuse of a minor by diocesan personnel, the Victim Assistance Coordinator must also be informed. Sexual misconduct violates human dignity and the mission of the church. The spiritual well-being of all victims, their families, and others in the community is of particular concern to the church.

Report child abuse

Every allegation of child abuse must be reported to Child Protection Services, an agency of Indiana state government. CPS Toll-free: 800-800-5556. Local law enforcement: 9-1-1.

Report and inform

In the event of an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor (a person under 18) by diocesan personnel, report the allegation to authorities, and inform the Victim Assistance Coordinator for the diocese: Toll-free: 866-200-3004, Local: 812-490-9565.
