Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

To many, the traditional Christmas song "The Twelve Days of Christmas" is something of an enigma. Most just assume it is an old frivolous song. Even many secularist and agenda-driven websites such as Vox and Snopes will lay out fallacious arguments as to why it was simply a silly memorization exercise for small children. However, the origins of the lyrics are far more beautiful, weighty, and Godly.

Traditionally Christmas proper was celebrated from Christmas day through the celebration of Epiphany, a span of 12 days. The hymn itself originates from England, where from the time of Henry VIII's break from the Church to the early 19th century it was illegal and a capital crime to practice Catholicism. Therefore, priests who were risking their lives to keep the Faith alive in England composed these verses as code to catechize people in essential truths. So the symbols are as follows:

- 12 Drummers Drumming = 12 points of doctrine in the Apostles' Creed
- 11 Pipers Piping = the eleven faithful Apostles (minus Judas) who proclaimed (piped) the Faith
- 10 Lords a Leaping = 10 Commandments of God (as lords were those who judged and enforced law)
- 9 Ladies Dancing = 9 of the fruits of the Holy Spirit (Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control [chastity])
- 8 Maids a Milking = the 8 Beatitudes that extol the blessedness of the lowly and humble, since a milkmaid was about as low in standing as one could get. (Poor in spirit, mourners, the meek, those who desire righteousness, the merciful, the pure, peacemakers, the persecuted)
- 7 Swans a Swimming = the 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit, which make us full of grace, and swans are graceful (wisdom, knowledge, understanding, fortitude, temperance, justice, prudence); also the 7 Sacraments, the greatest source of grace (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Penance, Matrimony, Holy Orders, Anointing of the Sick).
- 6 Geese a Laying = the 6 days of creation
- 5 Golden Rings = the Pentateuch, or the first 5 books of the Bible
- 4 Calling Birds = the Four Evangelists (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) calling out and proclaiming the Gospel
- 3 French Hens = the Theological Virtues (Faith, Hope, Charity)
- 2 Turtledoves = the Old and New Testaments that give the entire story of salvation
- A Partridge in a Pear Tree = Jesus Christ, who would give His life to save us. It was believed at the time that the female partridge was one of the only birds that would willingly give their life to defend their chicks.

May we always ponder and give thanks for all these gifts of faith in our lives!

Diocesan Policy: Report and Inform

The Diocese of Evansville has in place a policy that requires that any allegation of child abuse must be reported to civil authorities. If an allegation involves the sexual abuse of a minor by diocesan personnel, the Victim Assistance Coordinator must also be informed. Sexual misconduct violates human dignity and the mission of the church. The spiritual well-being of all victims, their families, and others in the community is of particular concern to the church.

Report child abuse

Every allegation of child abuse must be reported to Child Protection Services, an agency of Indiana state government. CPS Toll-free: 800-800-5556. Local law enforcement: 9-1-1.

Report and inform

In the event of an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor (a person under 18) by diocesan personnel, report the allegation to authorities, and inform the Victim Assistance Coordinator for the diocese: Toll-free: 866-200-3004, Local: 812-490-9565.
