Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we are beginning the Lenten season, it is with great expectation and enthusiasm that we also look forward to the upcoming parish mission! I for one would love to have a bit of a spiritual tune-up. We welcome Fr. Peter Marsalek, SOLT (Society of Our Lady of the Trinity) to St. John's next weekend to preach our weekend Masses and to give a series of three spiritual conferences on Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday evenings.

Fr. Marsalek has a rather impressive spiritual, academic, and personal résumé. He hails from Toronto, Ontario, and is a former semi-pro tennis player and engineer. He subsequently joined SOLT and was ordained priest in 2005. He earned a Sacred Theology Doctorate in Rome. Since 2013 he has served as the General superior of the priestly division of SOLT. Prior to this he proved himself a very capable and gifted administrator, serving as the head of catechesis for the Diocese of Corpus Christi, Texas, the president of two Catholic high schools, and finally being the rector of SOLT's seminary in Detroit. In addition to all these impressive attributes and assignments, he is a genuinely humble, holy, and kindly man.

The theme of the retreat revolves around the Father-son or Father-daughter relationship that we are called to have with God. Too often we tend to approach God either in a mindset of Master-slave or Buddy-buddy. The reality is that God intends a relationship with us that is far broader and deeper than either of these. I sincerely look forward to the spiritual enrichment Fr. Marsalek will offer us.

The mission will run from Saturday March 7 through Tuesday March 10th as follows:

Diocesan Pastoral Council

The Diocese of Evansville's newly reconstituted Diocesan Pastoral Council had its first meeting on Feb. 1, at the Catholic Center in Evansville. The DPC is an advisory group to Bishop Siegel, and is made up of three lay members from each deanery and one representative each from the priests, deacons, consecrated religious, & young adults of the diocese. This gathering served as an orientation for the members.

Following Mass, Bishop Siegel opened the meeting by sharing his vision for the DPC. The Bishop noted that the Council, like other consultative bodies in the Diocese, is to bring together a broad perspective on needs, concerns and plans that involve and impact the whole diocese. Rather than discussing issues of a specific parish, school, office or community, it will look to broader pastoral trends and possible areas of initiative. For that reason, the members of the Council represent a cross-section of the diocese, not just geographically; it is a diverse group of men and women representing various age groups, backgrounds, vocations and professions.

During the meeting, Diocesan Vice-Chancellor Dominic Faraone provided a presentation that explored the DPC Constitution and By-Laws. Diocesan Chancellor and COO Tim McGuire followed with a session reviewing the diocesan administrative and pastoral offices, consultative bodies to the Bishop and diocesan activities. The meeting concluded with final comments from the Bishop, an opportunity for a Q&A, and recommendations for future agenda items. The next meeting is scheduled for May 9.

Diocesan Policy: Report and Inform

The Diocese of Evansville has in place a policy that requires that any allegation of child abuse must be reported to civil authorities. If an allegation involves the sexual abuse of a minor by diocesan personnel, the Victim Assistance Coordinator must also be informed. Sexual misconduct violates human dignity and the mission of the church. The spiritual well-being of all victims, their families, and others in the community is of particular concern to the church.
