

Information for Parents: 2018-2019

1. First Communion preparation is a two year process. The only exception to this is if the child attended Summer Enrichment classes at Holy Name in 2018 and was enrolled in at least the 3rd grade or higher (during the time he/she attended the summer enrichment)
2. It is mandatory that all of the children attend 8:45 am Mass with their class each Sunday.
3. If the child is baptized, a copy of the baptismal certificate is required and due at the time of registration.
4. If the child is **not baptized**, a copy of the birth certificate is required.
5. Sacramental preparation classes are offered for children who are in grades 1-12.
6. Parents of any child receiving sacraments must be registered parishioners in a Catholic church. A registered parishioner is one who attends mass on a regular basis, receives and uses offertory envelopes. If you are not a member of this parish, we do require a letter of permission from your parish in order for the child to receive the sacrament at Holy Name Church.
7. Attendance for the child will be monitored. If there are too many absences you will receive a telephone call from our office. At this point it will up to the DRE, the child's teacher and or the Pastor as to whether the child will receive the sacrament or not.
8. Classes are offered in English or Spanish.
9. The fee for Faith Formation is \$100.00
10. The fee for confirmation is \$125.00
11. Religious Education is an ongoing process and we encourage you to continue your child's religion classes even after he/she has received the sacraments.
12. Classes for adults who desire to receive the sacraments are also offered.
