

## Information for Parents: 2019-2020

1. First Communion preparation is a two year process. The only exception to this is if the child attended Faith Formation classes at Holy Name in 2018-2019, attended Faith Formation classes at another parish in 2018-2019 (proof of this is required) or attended our Summer Enrichment class in 2019 and was in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade or higher and wasn't late or tardy.
2. Class hours are: 8:30 AM until 11:15 AM. Please be sure to obtain a class schedule.
3. If the child is baptized, a copy of the baptismal certificate is required and due at the time of registration. If the child is **not baptized**, a copy of the birth certificate is required.
4. Sacramental preparation classes are offered for children who are in grades 1-12.
5. Parents of any child receiving sacraments must be registered parishioners in a Catholic church. A registered parishioner is one who attends mass on a regular basis, receives and uses offertory envelopes. If you are not a member of this parish, we do require a letter of permission from your parish in order for the child to receive the sacrament at Holy Name Church.
6. Attendance and tardiness of the child will be monitored. If there is excessive absences or tardiness you will be notified. At this point the decision will be made by the DRE, the child's teacher and or the Pastor as to whether the child will receive the sacrament or not.
7. Classes are offered in English or Spanish. Special Education are also offered.
8. The fee for year 2 students is \$125.00. This includes all materials necessary, a t-shirt, first communion retreat and a photo of the child's first communion as well as a group picture provided by Moya Photography.
9. Fee for year 1 students is \$100.00. This includes all materials necessary, and a t-shirt.
10. The fee for confirmation is \$150.00 please contact the Parish Office for more information.
11. Religious Education is an ongoing process and we encourage you to continue your child's religion classes even after he/she has received the sacraments.
12. Classes for adults who desire to receive the sacraments are also offered.
