Service Requirements

Candidates in the Confirmation Program must include service as a fundamental part of their preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Why do we require service as part of our Confirmation program? Service hours are meant to inspire in each candidate a love for God and a love for neighbor.

Jesus, through His life, gave examples of serving others. On the night before He died, Jesus gave His friends both a great challenge and a wonderful promise. By washing their feet, like the lowliest servant, Jesus challenged His friends to bring love and service to all people, everywhere. (John 13:5-14). Today, we do that by word and action in our own lives.

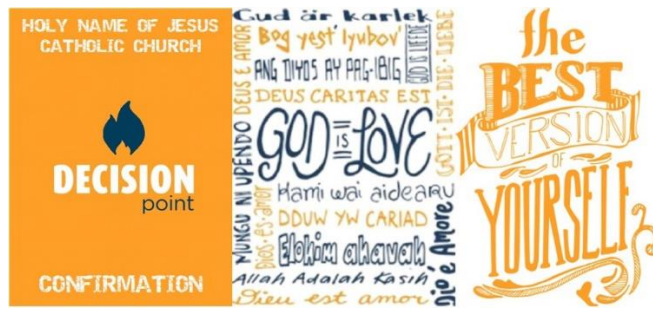
Service is an action of goodwill that contributes to the welfare of others. Service is done free of charge and there should be no compensation for the service provided.

Any youth involved in youth ministry is required to share their time and talent in at least one other ministry at Holy Name of Jesus Church. Candidates should record this under: One (1) "Full Year" Service Commitment (Examples – Altar Server, Choir, Usher, Lector, A/V Ministry and/or Hospitality). Candidates for Confirmation are required to complete Five (5) "One Time" Service Commitments from either Church (Examples – Fall Fest, Spring Festival (Mardi Gras), Dinner Auction, A Christmas Related Project etc.) or Community (Examples – Beach clean-up, coaching soccer, Feeding South FL, Homeless Coalition). All Confirmation Youth are required to participate in the Mission of Joy as our Annual Confirmation Project.

We recommend you work with your parents and or your Sponsor to complete these service requirements.

Every year the Youth Ministry hosts a Ministry (Service) Night where the Ministries in the Church showcase their Ministries so teens and candidates can sign up for service opportunities for the upcoming year. Candidates are often able to secure all their service opportunities at a Ministry (Service) Night. This year's Ministry (Service) Night is scheduled for **Sunday October 6, 2019 at 6:30pm**. In addition to helping the candidates fulfill their requirements, the community is greatly served with these candidates' volunteer hours.

** Remember – If you sign up for a project and cannot attend, please call the coordinator as a courtesy and let them know you will not be attending and why.

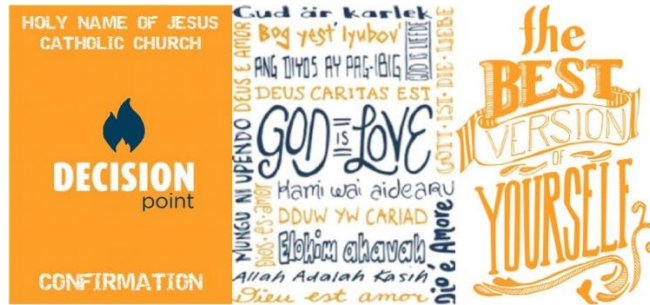

Confirmation Letter to the Bishop

A significant part of the Confirmation process is to write a letter to the person who administers the Sacrament. Unfortunately, this person is not able to get to know each of you individually. Therefore, it is requested you write a letter to him so he knows a little bit more about you. The letter should be typed on plain white paper. It should also be single-spaced using a Times New Roman font with a font size of 12. Please follow the example below:

Date:

Greeting: Dear Bishop Barbarito,

Body Includes:The first paragraph answers the question - Who are you? It introduces you to the Bishop. Remember to state your full name. Tell him something about yourself, your family, your school, activities, and where you were born etc.

The second paragraph answers the question – Why do you want to be confirmed? Hopefully by this point in your preparation you have moved beyond the response, “Because my parents are making me.” For most of you this has been at least a two year process. Think back to how you felt signed up for these classes. Think about how you feel now. How has this process changed you? How has your relationship with God and others changed?

The third paragraph answers the question - Who is your chosen sponsor and why? How did you make this decision? What makes your relationship with this person special or different?

The fourth paragraph answers the question - What Confirmation name are you taking and why? Why is this name special to you? What is the history of this name? Tell a little about why the saint is special to you.

The fifth paragraph answers one of the most significant questions of the letter - What change is Confirmation going to make in your life? What are you going to do after Confirmation? What impact is this going to have on you, your home life, your church life, your community, the world? How are you going to make a difference?
