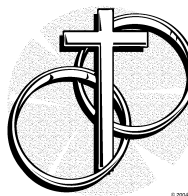

The **Parish Pilgrimage to Lourdes and Fatima** celebrating the 90th anniversary of the establishment of Holy Trinity Parish is scheduled for October 8 through October 19. Msgr.
