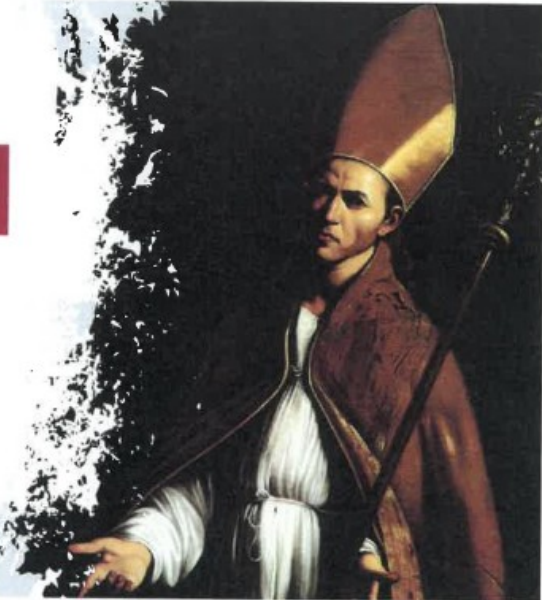
Saint Januarius
