
Along with my brother priests and deacons, I want each of you to know how grateful I am for your time, talent, and treasures. May God bless you and your families.













SCHOOL INCOME \$4.6M

SACRAMENTAL LIFE OF SFA

Christ instituted the sacraments of the new law. There are seven: Baptism, Confirmation, the Eucharist, Penance, the Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders and Matrimony.

The seven sacraments touch all the stages and all the important moments of Life in Christ: they give birth and increase, healing and mission to the Christian's life of faith. There is thus a certain resemblance between the stages of natural life and the stages of spiritual life. The following number of parishioners received sacraments:

PARISH HIGHLIGHTS
