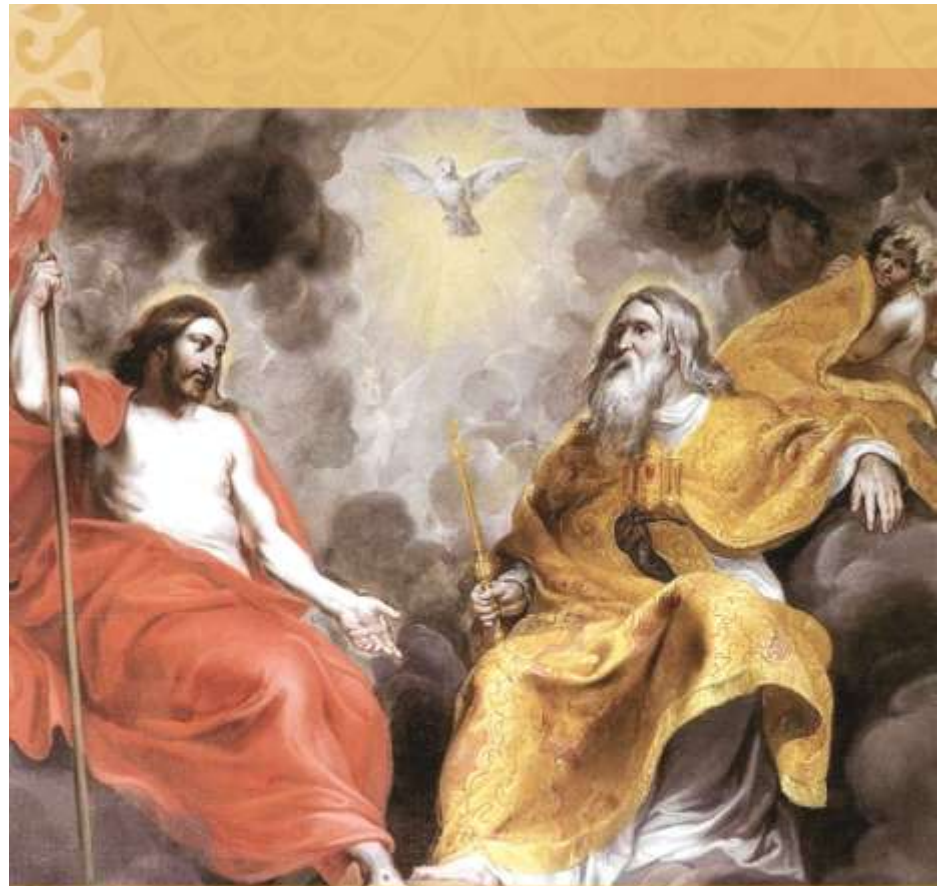

The cathedral is in need of replenishing the EM pool for all masses. Assisting with the distribution of Holy Communion is an important part of our Cathedral masses.

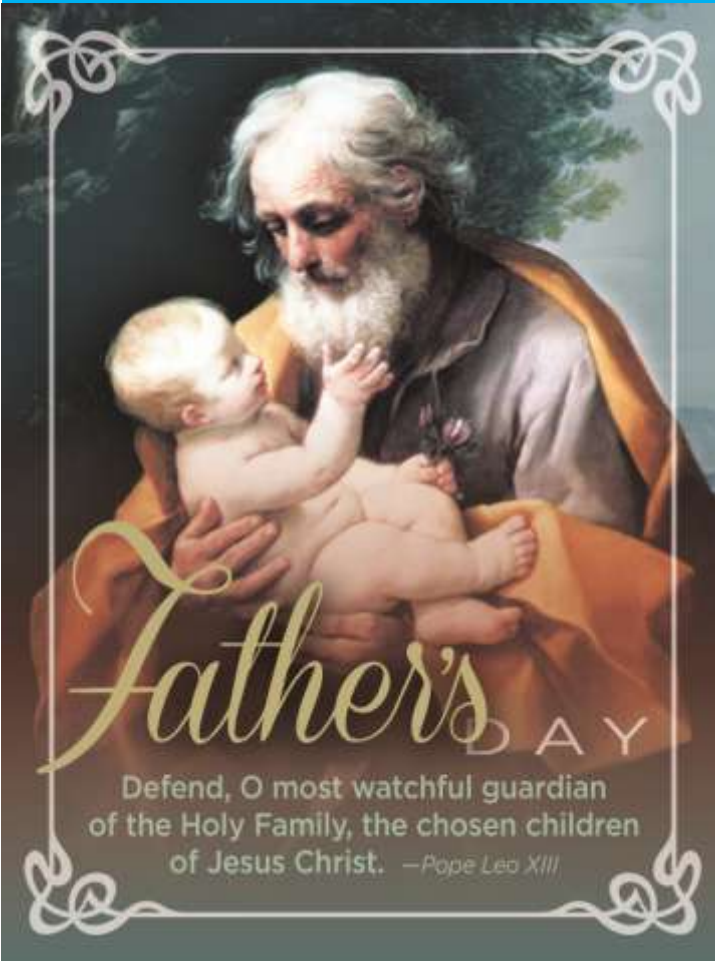

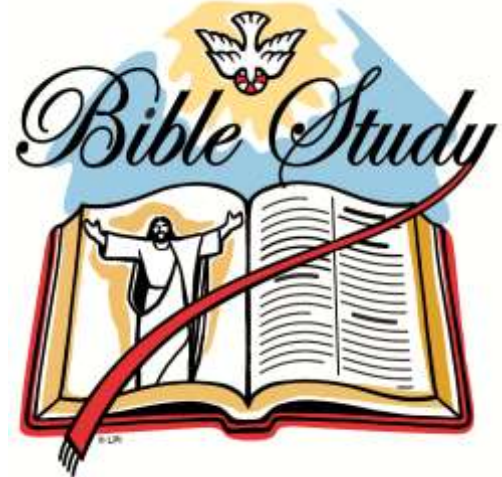

## LIFELONG CONVERSION

SAVE THE DATE: JUNE 23RD CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION. We're presently featuring elements of the "Liturgical Life" of the Catholic Church as part of our Stations of Lifelong Conversion. This segment will culminate with a Corpus Christi procession following the 11:30AM mass and before the Hispanic mass. Why a procession of Corpus Christi? Several reasons actually including 1) processions teach that the Catholic Church is necessary for salvation. The procession issues (proceeds, hence the name procession) from the church and returns thither, to show that we must enter the Church on earth if we would reach the Church in heaven; 2) processions also teach that you must take up your cross. The cross is carried first, because in this life we can never be wholly free from crosses and sufferings, if we follow the maxims of Our Lord; 3) the banners remind that we are the Church Militant, that we are warriors, because here below we have constantly to contend against the malignant foe and our own evil proclivities; 4) processions are two-by-two, a reminder that Our Lord sent the disciples out in twos; and 5) meant to Impress the Non-Believer, following the Catechism that "This solemn ceremony ... cannot fail to impress every beholder, and lead the non-Catholic to inquire what it is towards which such profound reverence and veneration is displayed."
