Family Tribute (optional—done before Mass)

- total of <u>5-7 minutes</u> allowed for tribute, **no matter how many people speak**
- suggested only 1 or 2 people speak, choir microphone and stand will be used
- write down what you want to say, it helps you stay focused and within the time limit

(Longer tributes negatively impact the timing of all that follows: Mass, luncheon and burial.)

Your tribute should include some of these suggestions:

- tell something that has been very **meaningful** in your relationship with this person
- speak of his/her **good qualities or virtues** (goodness, strength, courage, love or patience) or **life lessons** you learned from this person
- say how he/she has been **inspirational** in your life or how you have been **touched/changed by knowing this person**
- tell something of his/her religious beliefs and how he/she lived a life of faith in God and the church
- quote a poem, song or writing with a **positive message** that fits well with his/her life
