# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

\*As previously announced, Fr. Norman appointed three members of the Senior Advisory Group (S.A.G.), Del Eulberg, Syd Muenster and Herb Escobar, to do a study that has been titled: "St. Peter's Staff Needs Analysis." They interviewed each member of the parish staff to determine current challenges and opportunities in meeting the increased needs of the parish with a focus on IT and overall staff operations. The most significant recommendation was that St. Peter's Parish create a new staff position, that of an Business Office Manager, and hire one within the next four to six months. This new position will be under the direction of the pastor, and will function as the Chief Operations Officer, managing/ leading all parish business and pastoral requirements. The Business Office Manager will manage all Human Resources functions and all parish staff will report directly or indirectly to this position. This recommendation has been approved and the job description has been developed. The salary and benefits will be incorporated into the parish budget for Fiscal 2018-19. In the coming months we will be advertising this position, accepting applications, screening them, and doing interviews leading to a hire. As parish administration, pastoral outreach and function get more complicated and demanding, and as our parish continues to grow, this position is meant to distribute the workload of two existing staff positions (bookkeeper and Pastoral Administrator), better orchestrate parish operations, improve effectiveness of staff relations internally, within the parish and in the larger community of Boerne. We will keep you informed as developments unfold in this process. Overall, we want to better serve our parishioners and the Boerne community. Thanks to Del, Syd and Herb for their volunteer services doing this study. All other recommendations will be addressed in future staff meetings and workshops, etc.

\*This weekend we celebrate the Archbishop's Annual Appeal In-Pew Weekend here at St. Peter the Apostle Parish. We are on a different time-line this year due to our Combined Capital Campaign that was conducted between late 2017 and March 2018. Please see the AAA information on the next page of this edition of the Bulletin. Thank you for your participation as in past years and your continuing generosity.

\*Our congratulations to Sr. Frances Briseno, OSB, who has been named the new Prioress of the Benedictine Sisters for the period 2018-2023. Sr. Frances' installation with the new Council of Sisters will take place in mid-May at the St. Scholastica Monastery. We welcome Sr. Frances to this role in which we will collaborate as a parish and convent in the mission of spreading the Gospel of Jesus in our respective communities and ministries. We acknowledge and thank Sr. Bernardine Reyes for her two successive terms as Prioress. She has been a steady presence in the Benedictine Community, St. Peter's Parish and the larger Boerne and Hill Country area. Our gratitude and blessings go with Sr. Bernardine as she takes a short sabbatical before resuming her ministries here. God's speed to you!

hear, ponder, and celebrate the most essential mysteries of the Christian faith as revealed in the scriptures and the liturgy.

7. The catechist of the Good Shepherd does not incorporate into the catechesis themes other than those which emerge from the essentiality and specificity of the vital needs of the children and our work with them.

#### EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP Recognize God in your Ordinary Moments

In the Church, we observe a liturgical calendar that takes us through the life of Jesus and highlights fundamental doctrines of our faith. Starting with this Sunday, our observance of the Easter Season continues for one more week until the celebration of Pentecost. While many outside of the Church only see Easter as a one-day celebration, we celebrate for an entire season, much like we do during Christmas as well. Of course, this calendar only serves to remind us and point to greater realities.

We are not called to be more generous at Easter or Christmas than we are on other days. We do not choose to love more during one time of the year. The fact is that Jesus is alive right now and at all times is calling us to give of ourselves.

When we make an intentional decision to follow Jesus and adopt a stewardship way of life, we commit ourselves to this journey 365 days a year. We are an Easter people at all times. The high and low points of our journey are not tied to a liturgical year, but instead to our own experiences of life and shortcomings. A season or holiday may make it easier to have a giving attitude, but we need to do the same when little around us is pointing us in that direction. It is sometimes when few are paying attention that love and generosity are most needed.
