FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

*As promised in my talk/homily at all masses last weekend, I have inserted within this bulletin, alongside this section, the "Archdiocese of San Antonio Procedures for Reporting Abuse." Please read it carefully and keep it in an easily accessible place in case you need it in the future. Or, go online to find it and other information relative to this issue of addressing sexual abuse in the church. Thank you to everyone for your multifaceted feedback, gratitude and support for my addressing this issue during the weekend services.

*Due to enough inquiries, I have posted the talk/ homily given last weekend on our St. Peter the Apostle Parish website. You can access it on the menu at the top of the website - FR. NORM'S STATEMENT ON PRIEST SEXUAL ABUSE. Thank you for your interest.

*Archbishop Gustavo Garcia-Siller issued a statement immediately following the release of the Pennsylvania District Attorney's report. There is a section prominently displayed on the Archdiocesan website at www.archsa.org with the heading "Penance, prayer and fasting," which contains material in English and Spanish, such as the archdiocesan statement, statements from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), and from Pope Francis concerning this crisis. The section is updated with new, late-breaking material.

It includes the August 27th statement from Cardinal DiNardo regarding the USCCB request for an apostolic visitation to work in concert with a national lay commission granted independent authority to seek the truth. In addition, a copy of that statement is included. This material is also shared on the various social media outlets of the Archdiocese.

The Archdiocesan statement includes contact information and a description of the Office of Victim Assistance and Safe Environment, background on the USCCB's "Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People," and the response of the Archdiocese to sexual abuse allegations they have received since 2002. As parishioners, please feel free to access this information to be more informed.

The allegations last Saturday from the former apostolic nuncio to the United States have been the subject of intense media coverage and social media reaction. We should all withhold judgments concerning the veracity of these or any related

charges until they have been properly and thoroughly investigated and a finding can be made of their veracity.

Let us be about truth-finding, justice, prayer and penance in our journey ahead navigating through this very complicated and contentious matter. Please support the good, decent and even holy priests of our Archdiocese and Church as they continue to minister to the spiritual needs of all the faithful. Let us be a healing presence to one another. The joy of the Gospel of Jesus Christ must be proclaimed ever more fervently and passionately in these difficult times. Let us keep our gaze fixed on Christ and how he is leading our local church, and how we can best serve the needs of our people.

*We thank Archbishop Gustavo for spending more than two hours last Monday with our **St. Peter's**Men's ACTS team and then presenting and answering questions and visiting afterwards at the joint **Theology on Tap / Theology on the Rocks** event hosted at the Random Beer Garden.

Approximately 300 were in attendance as the Archbishop addressed the issue of priests' sexual abuse and its ramifications in the church. We thank Mark Crews and Carrie Sabine, leaders of Theology on the Rocks and Tap respectively, who organized and led this major event.

*In last weekend's bulletin I announced that Leroy Ferry and Elizabeth Nolan had been accepted into the 3-year Spiritual Direction Program at the St. Peter Upon the Water Retreat Center in Ingram, Texas founded by Bishop Michael Boulette. At the Ministry Fair last weekend I was formally informed that a third parishioner of St. Peter's Parish had also been admitted at the last minute: Brian Hammer. As a parish, we are very blessed to have these three very qualified candidates entering this program to serve in this greatly needed capacity in the future.

*The St. Peter's Knights of Columbus have begun to acknowledge the "Family of the Month" for their devotion to Catholic virtues and service in the faith-community. In the month of July the Jared & Debbie Wingfield family were honored and for August the Bret and Carol Haas family are being honored. As part of the award, they will be acknowledged in the Bulletin and are given a \$100 HEB gift-certificate. Congratulations! In the future, honorees will be announced in the KC's section of the bulletin.

Archdiocese of San Antonio Procedures for Reporting Abuse

If you have knowledge or suspicion that a child has been abused/neglected by a family member or stranger call **CPS** at **1-800-252-5400** or local law enforcement. A report can also be made online at **www.txabusehotline.org**.

If you or someone you know has been a victim of sexual abuse by a priest, deacon, or other church personnel and you wish to file a complaint:

- Contact the Office of Victim Assistance & Safe Environment at (210) 734-7786, or 1-877-700-1888, or email: ovase@archsa.org.
- You have the right to contact law enforcement or CPS at any time. Boerne Police Department: (830) 249-8645
- All calls or emails will be responded to within 48 hours.
- The Office of Victim Assistance & Safe Environment will ask for the following information:
 - The nature of the alleged abuse
 - The name and age of the victim at the time of the alleged abuse
 - ♦ The age of the victim at the time of the report
 - Contact information for the victim
 - ♦ The name of the alleged perpetrator
 - The date(s), time(s), location(s), and frequency of the abuse
- Non clergy cases are forwarded to an agency supervisor or to the Human Resources Dept.
 - ♦ Investigations will be handled on a local level
- For cases involving a member of the clergy:
 - A written report will be created and forwarded to the Archbishop or his designee.
 - The Office of Victim Assistance & Safe Environment will provide follow-up services including but not limited to counseling and spiritual guidance.
 - ♦ The victim has the right to contact a lawyer at any time during this process.

- The Archbishop or his designee will offer to meet
 with the victim.
- The Archbishop or his designee will contact the District Attorney.
- The Archbishop will notify the Archdiocesan Review Board (ARB); who will then notify am investigator.
- ♦ The investigator will report all findings to the ARB.
- ♦ Based upon their investigation, the ARB will make a recommendation to the Archbishop.
- This recommendation will state if the allegation is credible and requires further actions.
- ◊ If the allegation is considered credible:
 - A full investigation will be conducted according to Canon Law
 - The alleged perpetrator will be suspended from ministry
 - The faith community will be notified
 - If the perpetrator is cleared, he/her will be returned to ministry and their name will be restored
 - If the perpetrator is not cleared, then he/she will be permanently removed from ministry
- For any allegation, the Archdiocese will offer immediate assistance
 - Professional counseling services will be offered to the alleged victim
 - The professional counseling service will be offered through a list of approved providers
 - The alleged victim may choose his/her own counselor after approval by the Archdiocese
 - The Archdiocese will require progress reports from the counselor on a monthly basis for continued payment of service

Seeing to the welfare of victims is a primary duty of the Archdiocese of San Antonio when confronted with evidence of abuse. We are committed to providing respect, confidentiality, and pastoral healing to all who have experienced abuse by the clergy.
