

GOSPEL MEDITATION

Who did you come to see? A version of this question is posed by Jesus many times in the Gospels. He asks it of Andrew and John when they begin to follow him. He asks it of Mary Magdalene in the garden of the resurrection. He asks it in today's Gospel. "What did you go out to the desert to see?" There is something innately human about "seeing." Animals have eyes - some with much more powerful vision than our own — but that's not the kind of seeing Jesus is talking about. We could phrase the question several other ways. "What are you looking for?" "What are you longing for?" "Whom do you seek?"

It is in seeing for ourselves that our suspicions or hypotheses are confirmed, that our desires discover their fulfillment, and that we can rest for a moment in certainty. John the Baptist sought certainty of Jesus' identity. "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?" Jesus sends word to him based on the testimony of sight, observations of the mighty deeds Jesus has begun to work. "Go and tell John what you hear and see."

God recognizes our desire to see. In the Incarnation, the Word is made flesh. The invisible is made visible. The supernatural is made manifest in an infant who can do little more than the most natural of movements as he feeds, cries, sleeps. We don't need to wait for Christmas to see God. The work of God is all around us. Those blinded by sin "regain their sight." People overcome backgrounds of poverty and violence to make worldchanging contributions. Addicts grow and heal. Truth is spoken, and people listen. Let's pray for the grace to see God's movement in our lives this week. How have you seen the work of God?

MEDITACIÓN EVANGÉLICO

El tercer Domingo de Adviento recibe el nombre de Gaudet, que significa alegría. "Estén siempre alegres en el Señor; se lo repito, estén alegres y tengan buen trato con todos" (Filipenses 4:4), dice la antífona de entrada. La oración colectiva también nos lleva a reflexionar en el significado permanente de esta alegría: "Mira, Señor, a tu pueblo que espera con fe la fiesta del nacimiento de tu Hijo, y concédele celebrar el gran misterio de nuestra salvación con un

corazón nuevo y una inmensa alegría." El Profeta Isaías lo afirma con sus palabras de esperanza a su pueblo: "¡Animo! no teman. He aquí que su Dios, vengador y justiciero, viene ya para salvarlos."

La Navidad se acerca y su luz nos envuelve y llena de esplendor. Todo el ambiente es de fiesta y preparación. Las celebraciones Marianas nos han dejado ese gozo de albergue y acogida al que lo necesita. Ha, si comprendiéramos el motivo de alegría que decimos celebrar, entenderíamos perfectamente que se debe a que Dios y su salvación están cerca. La alegría y la salvación van juntas, no se pueden separar, nos dice la Liturgia. Por este motivo, Juan se alegra desde la cárcel al escuchar la respuesta que Jesús le envía: "Los ciegos ven, los cojos andan, los leprosos quedan limpios de la lepra, los sordos oyen, los muertos resucitan y a los pobres se les anuncia el evangelio. Dichoso aquel que no se siente defraudado por mí." Que la participación en la Eucaristía fomente actitudes que preparen a celebrar la Navidad en familia recordando v viviendo que Jesús nunca nos defraudará.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

Leading the Way

There are many examples of false prophets in history. Some of these gifted charlatans have led people away from family and friends. They have led people to do evil things, like stealing, torture, or even murder. It is amazing how those gifted with charisma can lead others down such a destructive path. In today's modern world filled with so much technology and sophisticated communication platforms, one must be careful not to buy into a lie or scam so easily.

John the Baptist didn't have any modern technology in his toolbox as he was preparing the way for the Messiah, Jesus. He moved people with a profound message and by the way he lived his life. People questioned whether he was the One who was to come, but he assured them that he was not the One. Instead, all he did was to prepare people for Jesus' coming.

You and I can either lead people to Jesus by our words and actions, or we can lead them away from him. Our stewardship can be a powerful witness to how Jesus has changed our lives. Unfortunately, if we are not changed

and instead act in ways that are contrary to a mature disciple, we can lead people down the wrong path. During the Advent season, there is much to be done in our homes and with our families to get ready for the celebration of Christmas. However, this is not about a day; it is about Jesus. May our actions and words bear witness to the transformative power of Jesus Christ in our lives, not just during this season, but all year long.







END OF YEAR AND CHRISTMAS GIVING

At this time of year many families are reviewing their financial situations and making decisions for charitable giving in light of possible tax advantages. A statistic published recently states that for many nonprofit organizations, including churches, up to one-third of their yearly income for budgeting comes from charitable donations given between November and December. St. Peter's Parish experiences a significant amount of its yearly income donated at this time of year as well, through the incredible generosity of our membership.

St. Peter the Apostle Church is a mission-driven parish following the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We share in a very transparent way how your generous contributions are used responsibly, fulfilling that mission while also preparing for our future growth. Our bulletin is a major vehicle of direct communication with the parish about the specific ways in which our organizations, ministries and services reach deep into the parish and larger Boerne community, serving people's needs in light of Bible teaching.

Catholic parishioner donations are made in light of the fact that, in the Christian Tradition, we believe that everything we have is a blessing and gift from God. Our charitable giving throughout the year is instructed by the biblically-based, long-held tenets of Stewardship - giving of Time, Talent and Treasurer.

We are now near Advent and Christmas, marking the preparation for and celebration of the greatest gift in history - God's gift of his only son, Jesus Christ, our Lord and Redeemer. The story of the Three Kings or wise men seeking and finding the Christ-Child is the backdrop of the tradition of gift-

bearing and giving at this time of the year. As stewards of God's abundant blessings and gifts to us throughout this year, let all our families consider and pre-plan for how you may include St. Peter's Parish in your charitable giving before year's end.

Your donations can be made to our parish general fund, our Capital Campaign, or specifically to an organization or ministry of the parish. You should designate your intentions at the time of your donation. Below we have reprinted the "Methods of Giving" pages we developed for uses in parish life. We trust it will be helpful in summarizing possible ways of giving from your resources. Thank you!

METHODS OF GIVING

Selecting the best way of giving for you depends on your personal financial situation and goals. As tax laws are always changing, and each individual's financial situation is different, donors are encouraged to consult a professional advisor (See "Note 1"). Consider the following suggested ways of donating:

Pledges

Pledges are commitments made in good faith, but are not legally binding. They are a promise of support you are making to St. Peter's. We encourage this way of giving, over a three-year period, as the best way to make a sacrificial gift maximizing the total amount of your support. We send reminders for your commitment based on your timing preference of either monthly, quarterly, semiannually or annually. Please also consider making an initial payment of ten percent of your gift when you make your pledge. This will allow St. Peter's and the archdiocese to begin project work immediately.

One-Time Gifts

One-time gifts provide immediate funding to St. Peter's. However,

unless your particular circumstances necessitate only a one-time gift, we encourage everyone to consider a pledge over a three-year period as the best way to make a sacrificial gift maximizing the total amount of your support.

WHAT YOU CAN DONATE

You can donate cash, check, money order or electronic money transfer in any amount and increment you decide. You may also make payments using credit cards, automatic withdrawal through online banking from your checking or savings account or through our online platform, WeShare (see "How to Donate).

You can donate stocks, bonds, mutual funds, EFTs, CDs, gold, freeand-clear owned real estate, art, life insurance policies, etc.

Real Estate. Current tax law allows donors of real property, which have been held for at least 12 months, to take an income tax deduction equal to the full market value with no capital gains tax.

Life Insurance. You may donate to the campaign by making St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church owner and beneficiary of your fully paid policy. The parish office will assist you with the correct wording.

Corporate Matching Gifts. A matching gift program provided through your employer or board membership may allow you to increase the value of your gift. Many companies match charitable gifts of their employees, retirees or board members. Consult your employer's human resources director or community outreach director to see if your company has a matching gift program.

Family Foundations and Community Funds. While we conduct research to discover foundations whose mission aligns with St. Peter's projects, there are many family foundations not listed in publications, especially those managed by a community fund. If you have a family foundation or contribute to a donor-advised community fund and you would like to invest in the future of St. Peter's and the archdiocese, please contact Marilyn Belcher or Debra Martini at (830) 816 -2233.

Donor Advised Funds (charitable accounts), once legally set-up and active, allow holders to receive deductions for donations immediately while spreading payments over the next several years. Grants from these funds can be made to qualified charities, such as your parish.

Accounts. If you are at the age 70^{1/2}, when you

must make a required minimum distribution (RMD) from your retirement account, that distribution is usually taxable at your ordinary income tax rate. However, by making a qualified charitable contribution directly from your retirement account to St. Peter's, you can fulfill your RMD requirement without paying any taxes on it. The parish office can provide more information about this method of fulfilling your pledge.

Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD), also called charitable IRA rollover. The requirements for QCDs are as follow, as summarized at RCSAdvisor.com, Retirement Capital Strategies, March 26, 2018:

- Donor must be 70^{1/2} or older.
- QCD is limited to \$100,000 per taxpayer per year.
- Donation must be from a traditional IRA (not SEP, SIMPLE, or beneficiary IRA).
- Donor-advised funds are not eligible to receive QCDs.

- Direct your IRA trustee to send funds directly to a 501(c)(3) charitable organization (churches qualify). The charity you donate to will not have to pay taxes on your donation, maximizing the benefit of your charitable contribution.
- Distributions will be reported as "Normal Distribution" on your IRS Form 1099-R. You will need to keep track of your donations in order to exclude them from income.
- Follow instructions for QCD on line 15 of your IRS Form 1040, or notify your tax preparer.
- If you itemize deductions, remember that you cannot deduct the charitable contribution if you have already excluded it from income. You are allowed just one tax break, not two.

Note 1: There are many types of qualified accounts including 401(k), 403(b), 457 plans and others in addition to IRAs, and they are all subject to the Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). However, under current rules, you can only do the QCD from a traditional IRA. If you want to apply this strategy to another type of qualified account, such as a 401(k) or a 403(b), you would need to roll that account over into an IRA. You would want to discuss such a move with your financial advisor or tax professional.

Note 2: You can also use your QCD to meet all or part of your IRA's Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). This RMD is usually taxable at your ordinary income tax rate. However, by making a qualified charitable contribution directly from your retirement account to St. Peter's, you can fulfill your RMD requirement without paying any taxes on it. Traditional IRA owners must start taking RMDs at age 70^{1/2} or face tax penalties. The charity must receive your donation by December 31st for you to apply it to that year's tax return. Roth IRAs do

not require distributions while the account holder is alive. It has been said that the QCD/RMD is one of the best remaining tax reduction incentives and means of charitable contributions one can make today.

Donate through your Last Will and overall Estate Plan. Such gifts are a lasting memorial and expand our parish's ability to continue its growth and be a strong Catholic presence in Boerne and surrounding Texas Hill Country.

HOW TO DONATE

We strongly encourage online electronic giving through *WeShare*, used in our parish for your convenience. See the online giving instructions on page 4 on how to set up your *WeShare* account, if you have not already. It allows you to donate using specific approved credit cards. Call Marilyn Belcher, our Finance Coordinator, if you have any specific questions or difficulties in setting up a donor account.

Disclosure 1: Any of the foregoing type donations should be executed only with the professional consultation and specific advice of your banker, broker, financial/investment advisor, accountant, tax professional, tax attorney, etc. There can be significant tax advantages to your donations, but all IRS laws must be followed for such purposes with full professional advice.

Disclosure 2: St. Peter's Parish has a brokerage account with Frost Bank to facilitate direct transfer of publicly traded securities (without your selling them) to meet IRS rules and for maximum tax benefit. After professional advice, you must instruct your financial/investment advisor/IRA trustee to transfer any assets you wish to donate. It cannot be done by our parish staff on your behalf. Please contact Marilyn Belcher, our Finance Coordinator, at (830) 816-2233 to receive instructions on how to transfer such donations to our parish through the Frost Bank account.






Our Capital Campaign Committee developed the content for a Brochure that serves as an update and renewed solicitation to our Combined Capital Campaign that is nearing the second year into the three year-pledge cycle. All this content has been very creatively organized into the official Brochure by our Communications Coordinator, Christina Galvez. This updated Brochure builds on and extends the original brochure designed by the Steier Group, Consultants for our Campaign. Our updated brochure was mailed out to all 2,530 families registered in our parish.

Our goals in developing this Brochure are: 1.) to thank all our present one-time donors and those fulfilling their pledges, 2.) to keep you fully informed of all the progress we have been making through the incredible generosity of our parishioners, and 3.) to renew our solicitation for additional pledges from families who have not yet given one-time donations or pledges toward the campaign. Our overall Campaign goal is to meet our fullest potential as a parish by exceeding the "Transformational Goal" of receiving pledges totaling \$6.6 million to pay off the loan made to purchase the new property at 416 Highland Dr. but also support the Archbishop in his On the Way -¡Ándale! Capital Campaign as is expected of all parishes of the Archdiocese.

UPDATE ON CAPITAL CAMPAIGN & LOAN PAYMENT FOR NEW PROPERTY PURCHASE

On October 22, 2019 John Belter, Chair of our St. Peter's Finance Council, transacted another \$200,000 payment toward the principal of the loan taken out to purchase our new property at 416 W. Highland Street. The original note was for \$3,943,000 for the purchase of 14.077 acres of land and approximately 16,000 square feet of buildings. Due to the incredible generosity of our parishioners making one-time donations and fulfilling pledges made to the Campaign, we have been able to pay down the loan to a balance due of \$1,631,101.00. That means that in 22 months of our Capital Campaign we have paid off 59% of the entire note. Congratulations, everyone! Let us keep the momentum going!




