Dear Boerne ISD Family,

As promised, I am writing to share current information with you about our school closure.

School Closure

All campuses and departments will be **closed on March 23-27**. All but essential staff will be working remotely during this time.

We have received a significant number of questions from our community about why BISD has not announced a long-term closure as other districts in the area have already publicized. The administration is prepared to provide distance/remote learning for as long as necessary.

The school board will meet on Tuesday, March 24, 2020, at 5:30 PM to receive an update about the impact of COVID 19 on BISD schools.
