- 3. What word or phrase caught your attention?
- 4. What feelings did the text invoke?
- 5. Read the Gospel again.
- 6. This time, think about:
 - a. Who is consoled in the Gospel?
 - b. Who is challenged in the Gospel?
 - c. What is God doing in this Gospel?
- 7. Read the Gospel again and think about...
 - a. What is the message of life/death for you? For others?
 - b. What is the cost for you? For the Church?

As you go through the various steps with the same Gospel (*Lectio Divina*), there should be a difference in the quality of the understanding. A community theme should emerge.
