FINANCIAL STATE OF THE PARISH

INCOME STATEMENT: Our Lady of Victory and Our Lady of the Snow reported an Operating Deficit for 2019-2020 before Extra-Ordinary items of \$49,912. Operating Income or Deficit is gross income (collections, revenue from the Early Childhood Program, gifts and other sources of revenue), less expenses incurred from operating activities such as salaries and benefits, the Early Childhood Program, office supplies, utilities, buildings and grounds expenses, and equipment and structural expenses. This is basically our day to day revenue and expenses. Extra-Ordinary Items include income and expense from the Memorial Garden project and the unrealized gain on our investments.

COLLECTIONS: Total revenue from collections totaled \$470,734, 1.5% over budget, and 1.9% over last year. Please consider becoming an electronic giver as it has no COVID-19 concerns, and it provides a steady income stream to the parish. Details are on the homepage of the website.

OTHER INCOME: Other Income, which includes donations and bequests, reigniting our faith, food pantry donations, stipends, and faith formation receipts totaled \$258,126, a \$82,436 increase over last year. As we have said in past years, we cannot plan gifts and bequests with any degree of accuracy. This year the food pantry received donations in the amount of \$21,511 to support the needs of the community they serve.

EXPENSES: Total expenses were \$944,078. Some of the larger expenditures included: Salaries and Benefits \$383,831, Equipment and Structural expenses \$100,341, Supplies \$26,477, and Maintenance and Repair \$67,015.

BALANCE SHEET (Statement of Financial Position):

Cash: Cash in the Bank was \$75,380. The line item, Cash - Bishops Appeal represents money collected for the Bishops Appeal, but not remitted to the Diocese as of June 30. It is offset by a payable to the Diocese in the same amount. It was paid in the first half of fiscal year 2020-2021.

INVESTMENTS: Our investments totaled \$545,166, compared to \$592,066 on June 30, 2019.

LONG TERM LIABILITIES: Our Long-Term Debt, payable to the Diocese, was \$65,880 on June 30, 2020. This remaining debt is non-interest loans from the Diocese.

Please note that the second part of the State of the Parish is a list of the updates to our facilities undertaken during the last fiscal year. These updates were financed through our regular collection income, and many of these projects were accomplished with in house and parishioner volunteer labor. This year's expenditures were \$30,090. These projects included enhancements to both Our Lady of Victory and Our Lady of the Snow properties as well as on-going preventive maintenance programs currently in place. One item, the renovation of the bathrooms in the parish center, is not reflected in this total. The cost was \$58,000. It was paid with funds from Re-Igniting Our Faith.
