# Discussion [Conversation]

\*Change for Change- about 160 canisters were distributed March 4 &5 at Faith Formation and Our Lady of Victory and Our Lady of the Snow. The canisters have also been placed at several local businesses (Ted's, Browns Brewing, Duncan's and Two Brothers) and we are still awaiting responses from several others.

St Francis Xavier Orphanage child sponsorship is \$3,000 a year and can be done individually or by a group. Partial sponsorship is available for education, health care, clothing, etc. Tax deductible donation forms will be given for full or partial sponsorships.
