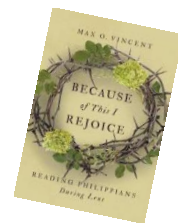
Pot-Luck Supper-March 6

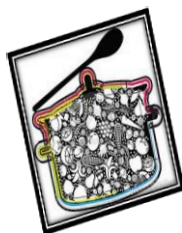

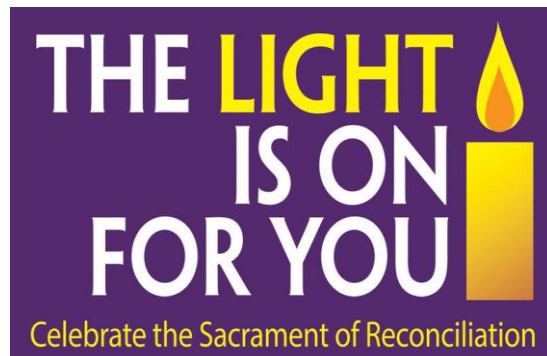
