

## Week #2: Overall Floor Plan, Canopy Entrance, & Fellowship Hall/Religious Education Space

## Overall Floor Plan

The Building Committee worked with architects to balance the needs of the parish with budget and space constraints. While compromises were made in virtually every space, the overall design meets the functional needs of each unique parish ministry or activity. As you review the floor plan, the major spaces include:



- Canopy Entrance & Drop off
- Adoration Chapel
- Multi-Purpose Room
- Janitor's Room & Storage
- Fellowship Hall/Religious
   Education space with serving kitchen and storage
- Gathering Space with new East Church Entrance, casket-size elevator, and ground-level public bathrooms
- Youth Room & North Entrance
- Montessori Classrooms and Playground

Main Canopy Entrance: This south entrance to the church and parish facilities has a canopy that extends over the handicap accessible drop-off area (not over the drive lane) large enough for 2 to 3 cars pulled up to the curb at once. Features include night-time lighting and push-button operation of exterior and interior vestibule doors. This will also be the main entrance to the Adoration Chapel (details in a future post).



## **Fellowship Hall and Religious Education Rooms**



This space is designed to serve many functions for the parish, Religious Education, and school, from large-group gatherings to small classroom settings.

- Accommodates up to 192 people in table and chair setting (larger gatherings will still be held in Parish Hall)
- Two double-door entrances from the Gathering Space, along with interior window to the Gathering Space.
- 10 ft. tall ceilings in the Fellowship Hall.
- Small serving kitchen for serving food not prepared on-site, or for serving food prepared in Parish Hall kitchen
  - Includes convection oven, three compartment sink, coffee maker, microwave, refrigerator/freezer, cabinets, and prep/work/serving counters.
- Operable partitions used for defining up to four Religious Education spaces for 12 students per room.
- Storage rooms for Religious Ed materials within each room.
- Religious Ed will use Fellowship Hall, church basement, and other campus spaces to facilitate all of their needs
