

Finally, we are actively pursuing the possibility of securing outside funding to help with the replacement of the church and rectory roofs — a matter which will need to be addressed much sooner than later if we wish to preserve what is beneath them. MARCH 20[™], LENTEN COMMUNAL PENANCE, 7PM

A number of guest priest will be with us to help celebrate this Sacrament in both English and Polish. Do take advantage of this last major occasion for confessions before Holy Week. Jesus died to take away our sins. Let Him do it!

MARCH 24[™], PALM SUNDAY

As we celebrate Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem at each weekend Mass, the Saturday Vigil at 5PM and Sunday at 8:30AM, 10AM Polish, and 11:30AM, palms will be blessed and distributed following Mass for use in the shrine areas and devotional places in our homes.

MARCH 28[™], HOLY THURSDAY, 7PM

The Mass of the Lord's Supper features the Washing of Feet symbolic of our Lord's "mandatum" the new commandment to be of loving service to others. The solemn Eucharistic Procession to the place of reposition concludes the ceremony and is followed by time for prayer in front of the Blessed Sacrament until (and we are one of the few churches still doing so) midnight. Accept Jesus' invitation and come to spend time in prayer with Him!

MARCH 29[™], GOOD FRIDAY

Today we commemorate our Lord's Passion and Death. It is a day of fast and abstinence. Stations of the Cross in English will be at 12 Noon followed by the Passion Service with Veneration of the Cross and distribution of Holy Communion at 2PM. The church will remain open throughout the day to venerate the Cross. Stations of the Cross in Polish will be at 6PM followed by Gorzkie Zale and the distribution of Holy Communion.

MARCH 30[™], HOLY SATURDAY

The traditional blessing of the Easter foods will take place on-the-hour at 10AM, 11AM, 12 Noon, 1PM, and 2PM. The Solemn Easter Vigil with the blessing of the new fire, extended Liturgy of the Word, Renewal of Baptismal Promises and blessing with the Easter Water, will be at 8PM. Note: there will not be afternoon confessions or the 5PM Vigil Mass this day.

MARCH 31st, EASTER SUNDAY

CHRYSTUS ZMARTWYCHWSTAL - CHRIST IS RISEN - ALLELUIA! Rezurekcja Mass at dawn in Polish with the traditional procession at 6:30AM. Solemn Masses of Easter with full musical accompaniment and with Renewal of Baptismal Promises and Blessing with the Easter Water at 8:30AM, 10AM in Polish, and 11:30AM. A happy and blessed Easter to all!!!

APRIL 1ST, DINGUS DAY, 10AM

Start your celebration of this "Drugi Dzien Swiat" the right way by joining us for a specially-timed Mass at 10AM. And, of course, we'll be doing the SPRINKLING RITE!

APRIL 6TH/7TH, DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY
