Godparents

Only one godparent is required for Baptism, but you may have two (one male & one female). A godparent must be an actively practicing Roman Catholic, fully initiated and at least 16 years of age. One baptized non-Catholic Christian may serve as a Christian Witness to the Baptism along with the Catholic godparent. Record the names & parish affiliations of your chosen godparents below. Godparents are asked to attend baptismal preparation at their home parish and to bring a letter from their parish stating that they have done so and meet the requirements listed above for serving as a baptismal godparent. If the Godparent is not a registered member at Holy Trinity Parish, he/she must complete a Godparent Eligibility Certificate, have it signed by the Pastor of his/her parish, and return it to Holy Trinity Parish Office at least a week prior to Baptism.
