FAMILY STORIES

Stories about the adventures, misadventures, achievements and comical incidents of family members provide a strong sense of connection, identity and inspiration for children. They are important to a child's development.

Children have a natural desire to know their family history, where they come from. The past helps shape who they are and may even provide a possible direction for their lives. Their future builds on their past. Children might even bear a physical resemblance to a distant relative.

Likewise, children enjoy hearing stories about their own past, things that happened to them when they were young. It's not unusual for such stories to be embellished over time, especially by siblings. The telling of these stories often becomes a family ritual.

It's important for parents to write a chronology of their own lives, including the details of their most significant experiences. My experience is that children become most interested in information about the history of their parents later in the children's own lives. I've heard many older adults express dismay that they didn't ask their parents more about the parents' early lives when they had the chance.
