### THE IMPORTANCE OF SELF-CRITICISM

With so much attention given to the issue of self-esteem, the value of healthy self-criticism has often been overlooked. Self-criticism, self-evaluation, is necessary if we want to improve areas in our personality and behavior which are weak.

Each of us should on a regular basis try to take an objective look at ourselves to see what needs correction. This doesn't mean that we are always putting ourselves down. In fact, it's a mistake to take ourselves so seriously that we can't even have a sense of humor about needed improvements. At the same time, we don't want our "growth issues" to go unaddressed and keep us from being the person we truly want to be.

The big challenge with self-criticism is to be open to areas in our life which need attention. We have to pray sincerely for the Holy Spirit to help us have this openness, to help us see in ourselves what we may not want to see. In addition, we should encourage people we trust to offer constructive criticism.

In our families, parents should create a culture in which identifying personal weaknesses is fostered without it being overdone. I can say that my wife and I were successful in this respect, as my children became quite comfortable in identifying perceived defects in their father's behavior.
