### THAT WOMAN YOU GAVE US

God could have sent Jesus to us any way He wanted, but He chose to send the Savior of humanity to earth through the womb of a woman. During this Christmas season, it's worth reflecting on why God chose this woman to play a major role in His plan of salvation.

After Adam and Eve sinned, God confronted Adam, asking for an explanation of what went wrong. Adam excused his own behavior by saying to God "That woman you gave me, she gave me the fruit, so I ate it." Adam is saying it's not just Eve's fault; it's God's fault for giving Eve to Adam in the first place.

Someone has to atone for Eve's role in the first sin, which is why God chose the spotless virgin, Mary, to be the New Eve. Mary is the woman God gave us, as evidenced by the words of Elizabeth when Mary went to visit her: "How does this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?"

At this time of year, it's a great idea to prayerfully ask the mother of our Lord to come to us, to lead us into a deeper relationship with Jesus.
