ABOUT SALVATION

This is the fourth installment of a series on how to talk to non-Catholics about the Catholic faith. I encourage parents to share these articles with their children.

On the issue of salvation, many Protestants believe that we are saved solely on the basis of faith. This belief is normally supported by a formal profession of Jesus as personal Lord and Savior.

A common misunderstanding of Protestants about Catholics is that we believe we can earn our way to heaven, as if there is a scorecard based upon how we live. On the contrary, the Catholic belief is that we are saved by grace through faith, and that our faith is evidenced by our works, by what we do in our lives on earth. The Catholic principal is based upon many passages in the Bible, especially Chapter 2 of the Letter of James.

Catholics could do a better job of helping young people understand the whole issue of salvation. We believe that we are saved by the suffering and death of Jesus Christ which atones for our sins and opens the doors to heaven for us. With the grace that flows from our relationship with Jesus, we can live the life Jesus requires of us.

"Everyone who listens to these words of mind but does not act on them will be like a fool who built his house on sand." Matthew 7:26
